Notes to the abbreviated financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2014

1 Accounting policies

Going concern

The Company has achieved encouraging results from recent scientific programmes and is in discussions with potential industrial and funding partners with the intention of taking this work further forward. During this period, the cash requirements will be minimal and the Directors believe that the Company will have sufficient resources to continue its business for at least 12 months from the date of signing of the accounts. As such, they are of the opinion that it is appropriate to prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis.

Basis of accounting

The financial statements are prepared on the historical cost basis of accounting and have been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

The financial statements do not include a cash flow statement because the company, as a small reporting entity, is exempt from the requirements to prepare such a statement under the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Depreciation of tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided on all tangible fixed assets at rates calculated to write off the full cost or valuation less estimated residual value of each asset over its estimated useful life. The principal rates in use are:

Computer equipment

25% on cost

Intangible fixed assets are stated at cost, and amortised on a straight line basis over the following periods:

Patents

over life of the patents

Deferred taxation

Deferred tax is provided in respect of the tax effect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

A deferred tax asset is regarded as recoverable and therefore recognised only when, on the basis of all available evidence, it can be regarded as more likely than not that there will be suitable taxable profits from which the future reversal of the underlying timing differences can be deducted.

Deferred tax is measured on a nondiscounted basis, at the average tax rates that are expected to apply in the periods in which the timing differences are expected to reverse, based on tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

Grants

Grants towards revenue expenditure are released to the profit and loss account as the related expenditure is incurred.

Research and development

Research and development expenditure is written off in the year in which it is incurred.

Hire purchase and lease transactions

Rentals under operating leases are charged to the profit and loss account as they fall due.
