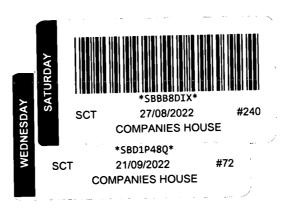

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Report of the Trustees for the Year Ended 30 September 2021

The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 30 September 2021. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective I January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The primary activity of the company in the year under review was managing Talla Stafainn (Staffin Community Hall). The secondary activity was maintenance of the premises.

Funds were raised through applications to charitable trusts, charges to Hall users and local fundraising events. The restaurant was leased out on a 6-month contract during the summer months to provide regular income. Staffin Stores Ltd also provided rental income.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Under the Memorandum and Articles of Association, the company has the power to make any investment which the management committee sees fit.

The management committee have agreed to maintain free reserves of approximately three month's running costs. This has been achieved throughout this financial year.

During the year under review the company recorded a cash deficit of £10,924 (before accruals). There was no income from the wind turbine feed-in tariff due to a delay in payments from the provider. There was no significant expenditure during this year apart from utilities and general maintenance.

Due to the Covid pandemic the Hall and public toilets were closed throughout the financial year in line with the lockdown regulations. This resulted in a loss of income from Hall hire, Gym usage and rent from the Restaurant. However, Staffin Stores was able to remain open providing rental payments. The Hungry Gull takeaway operated from the restaurant which provided further income.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes a limited company, limited by guarantee, as defined by the Companies Act 2006.

Organisational structure

Staffin Community Hall Association Limited is a company limited by guarantee and is registered in Scotland as a charity. The organisation is administered by a management committee which comprises the directors and some members of the company who meet approximately 6 times per year.

The company owns Staffin Stores Limited, a company limited by shares, which operates a convenience store within the Talla Stafainn premises. All the profits from Staffin Stores Limited are donated to Staffin Community Hall Association Limited after due allowance for commercial considerations such as increases in stock, equipment replacement and working capital.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings, they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Property

- 2% on cost

Improvements to property

- 2% on cost

Fixtures & equipment

- 15% on reducing balance

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.
