1 Significant accounting policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the company's financial statements.

Basis of preparation

Invercassley Windfarm (Scotland) (the "Company") is a company limited by shares and incorporated and domiciled in the UK.
