Accounting policies

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Changes in accounting policies

Following a review of the company's intangible fixed assets the directors have reassessed the useful life of the goodwill to 10 years. This was previously 20 years.

Goodwill

Goodwill, being the amount paid in connection with the acquisition of a business in 2006, is being amortised evenly over its estimated useful life of ten years.
