Structure Governance & Management

#### Constitution

The Charity is a company limited by guarantee which was incorporated on 4th December 2009 and granted charitable Status on 14th December 2009. The company is governed by its Memorandum and Articles of Association dated 26th November 2009.

#### **Appointment of Trustees**

Trustees are elected at the Annual General Meeting. Under the Memorandum and Articles of Association, there must be a minimum of three and not more than six elected trustees. The trustees may co-op a further two trustees if they consider it would be in the interests of the organisation to do so.

#### Management

The day-to-day administration of the charity is performed by an administrative team reporting to the chair of the trustees.

Objectives & Activities

#### Charitable purposes

The main charitable purpose of the trust is to provide, or organise, recreational facilities and activities, for the benefit of the communities of Clackmannanshire and the public at large with the object of improving their condition of life.

#### **Activities**

The trust has continued to the offer sports facilities (Bowling) for the residents of Clackmannanshire.

#### Trustees' Report

#### Achievements & Performance

There has been no activity other than the bowling section. This was due to the Sports pavilion being closed since November 2012 and the bowlers using the smaller Jubilee pavilion. The bowlers have had a particularly successful season winning several of the major competitions in the county.

Financial Review

#### Trustee remuneration and expenses

Our main source of income continues to be fees charged to members and monies raised by fundraising activities. The trustees did not receive any remuneration during the year.

Receipts on the unrestricted funds were £21,455 (2015: £35,591) which is much lower than most previous years due to the closure of the main Sports pavilion building, making a total of receipts £21,455. Payments for the year were £18,145 (2015: £26,773) which again is down on previous years. The resultant surplus for the year was £3,310 which will be added to the Trust's reserve funds.

#### Reserve Policy

The trustee's policy is to maintain reserves at around three months of normal running costs in order to meet commitments and to cover any unexpected expenditure. Reserves at the end of the year were £18,467 which is over the target range.

The policy is to ensure that reserves do not fall below £6,000.

Plans for Future Periods

The current board has set up new robust policies and procedures in order to ensure the correct running of the charity in the future.

#### Accounting policies

#### **Basis of preparation**

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005)', issued in March 2005, the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015) and the Companies Act 2006.

#### Fund accounting policy

Unrestricted income funds are general funds that are available for use at the trustees' discretion in furtherance of the objectives of the charity.

Restricted funds are those donated for use in a particular area or for specific purposes, the use of which is restricted to that area or purpose.

Further details of each fund are disclosed in note 14.

#### **Incoming resources**

Donations are recognised where there is entitlement, certainty of receipt and the amount can be measured with sufficient reliability.

Income from charitable activities includes income recognised as earned (as the related goods or services are provided) under contract.

#### Resources expended

Liabilities are recognised as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to the expenditure. All expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all costs related to the category.

Costs of generating funds are the costs associated with attracting voluntary income.

Charitable expenditure comprises those costs incurred by the charity in the delivery of its activities and services for its beneficiaries. It includes both costs that can be allocated directly to such activities and those costs of an indirect nature necessary to support them.

#### Governance costs

Governance costs include costs of the preparation and examination of the statutory accounts, the costs of trustee meetings and the cost of any legal advice to trustees on governance or constitutional matters.

#### Fixed assets

Individual fixed assets costing £500 or more are initially recorded at cost.

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#### Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on tangible fixed assets so as to write off the cost or valuation, less any estimated residual value, over their expected useful economic life as follows:
