Hill City CIC (formerly ESaint CIC) continued to operate on a part-time basis. We used our third year of operations to continue to assess the suitability and viability of our services:

- -Affordable unlimited web hosting
- -Affordable web development support (bespoke workshops)

Our services have benefited the community in the following ways:

- We provided unlimited web hosting for a few churches, a Christian individual, and a Christian organisation. Our hosting was deemed excellent value for money, and was delivered with a personal touch.
- We designed and delivered a bespoke training workshop entitled "Our organisation on the web" for a number of people from a local church. This resulted in the church being able to design, build and maintain its own website. The feedback received from the workshop was very positive.

Hill City's stakeholders are the people who form the congregations of local churches in the United Kingdom. This year, we consulted with some of our stakeholders verbally through personal interviews, on ideas for the future direction of the services of the company.

It was acknowledged that the future financial viability and social impact of the company should be improved. To this end, Hill City (formally ESaint CIC) applied the following actions as part of a re-branding exercise:

- It was decided to prioritise the provision of affordable unlimited web hosting as the company's core business, and to make this available also to people and organizations who were not originally our stakeholders. The rationale behind this was future financial viability for the company, and to offer the benefits of the service more widely.
- 2. It was decided that the profits from the provision of web hosting would be used to fund a community project which would benefit the local community. The rationale behind this was to maximise the social impact of the services provided by the company. A pilot community project is planned with a feasibility pilot in late 2015, and a fuller pilot in 2016.
- 3. In order to mark the two transitions outlined above, ESaint CIC was renamed to Hill City CIC on 3rd February 2015.
