PART 1 - GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE COMPANY'S ACTIVITIES AND IMPACT

Owing to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Company has been unable to hold any events in the year under review. It is currently hoped that an event – perhaps on a more limited scale - will be possible in late 2022.

The Company's sole activity is the planning, preparation and delivery of a single annual music and beer festival with the sole purpose of raising money for local charities. Through this event the Company promotes both community development through the donation of any surplus to local Moray-based charities, and the advancement of the arts, heritage and culture of the region by providing a platform for showcasing the food, beer and music of Moray, Grampian and the Highlands.

Any surpluses earned by the Company's activities are either transferred to the Elgin Rotary Club for disbursement according to the charitable objectives of that organisation, or retained within the Company to support future events, such purpose being considered directly analogous to and consistent with the company's sole object.

The Company's activities have benefitted specifically the residents of Moray, including children and young people, older people, people with disabilities or health problems, and local charities and voluntary bodies. Since the event was first held, a total of £14,000 has been transferred to the Elgin Rotary Club.

PART 2 - CONSULTATION WITH STAKEHOLDERS

The Company's stakeholders are the residents of and visitors to Moray, and local producers of food and drink products across Scotland.

The Company relies upon the Elgin Rotary Club for ensuring the distribution of any surplus according to local need. Whilst the Company itself has not consulted directly with this group, the Elgin Rotary Club is long-established and has developed excellent relations with local charities and non-profit organisations with which it maintains regular dialogue.

The Directors of the Company are all resident in Moray and have been actively engaged in the local and national food and drinks sector for many years, and developed the model for the Company's annual event from the experience earned working alongside stakeholder organisations when supporting and participating in similar events across the country.
