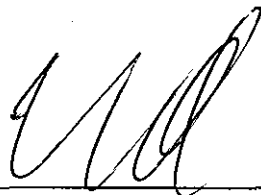

ORDER

UPON THE PETITION of the above named The Bury Football Club Company Limited of Gigg Lane, Bury, Lancashire, BL9 9HR (hereinafter "the Company")

AND UPON HEARING Counsel for the Company

AND UPON READING the Witness Statement of John Smith with exhibits "JS1" to "JS4" in support of the said Petition

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. An Administration Order is made in respect of the Company and that during the period for which this Order is in force the affairs business and property of the Company be managed by the Administrators hereinafter appointed by this Order pursuant to the provisions of section 8(3) of the Insolvency Act 1986 ("the Act") for the following purposes:
 - 1.1 the survival of the Company and the whole or any part of its undertaking as a going concern;
 - 1.2 a more advantageous realisation of the Company's assets than would be effected on a winding-up; and/or
 - 1.3 the approval of a Voluntary Arrangement under Part I of the Act.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

1. that Matthew Dunham, Charles William Anthony Escott and Michael John Hore of RSM Robson Rhodes, Colwyn Chambers, 19 York Street, Manchester, M2 3BA be appointed joint administrators ("the Administrators") of the Company;
2. that time for service of the Petition be abridged pursuant to Rule 12.9 of the Insolvency Rules 1986;
3. that any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by an Administrator may be done by either or all of the Administrators or any persons for the time being holding that office;
4. that pursuant to Rule 7.31(5) of the Insolvency Rules 1986 the Report prepared under Rule 2.2 of the Insolvency Rules 1986 and the witness statement of John Smith is not to be made open to inspection without leave of the Court;
5. that the costs of and incidental to the Petition (including the legal expenses thereof and the costs of and incidental to the report prepared pursuant to Rule 2.2 of the Insolvency Rules 1986) be paid as an expense of the Administration; and
6. that the Order be limited in time to 15 March 2002, on which date the Administrators shall return to Court for an extension of the Order or seeking a discharge of the Order.
