1990 FINANCIAL RESULTS

I am pleased to report that in the year ended 31st May, 1990 the Group made a profit for the year of £702,228 compared with a loss in the preceeding year of £734,761.

I am encouraged by our attacking style of play which resulted in 71 league goals being scored in the season, a number only bettered by Liverpool, the ultimate league winners.

The Littlewoods Cup was in the end a disappointment and the concession of a late equalising goal to Oldham at home once again caused us to be knocked out of a competition in which we had the opportunity to appear as finalists. After the magnificent victory away at Tottenham the club was unfortunate to be drawn away at Liverpool in the FA Cup and was knocked out of the competition at an early stage.

Prospects

Last season saw the addition to our staff of two further full Internationals S. Lee (England) and A. Cherednik (U.S.S.R.) and I. Andrew an England Under 21 International. During the summer a further U.S.S.R. International S. Gotsmanov has joined the Club.

It is the intention of the management to further strengthen the playing squad when suitable players become available.

Your Board look forward to the coming season with confidence.

Mike Richards, F.C.A. joined the Board as finance director during the year and his expertise and enthusiasm are welcomed.

In conclusion I would like to thank all the staft of the group for their support throughout the year and for their efforts in achieving the results under review.
