REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS

The Directors have pleasure in submitting their SIXTY-EIGHTH ANNUAL REPORT to the Members together with the audited Accounts for the year ended 31st May, 1978.

We are delighted that once again the team improved on the previous season's record. Although we were naturally disappointed that we did not actually "bring home" a Championship or Cup, the titles eluded us by the narrowest of margins. Finalists at Wembley in the F.A. Cup, a defeat by Liverpool in the Semi-Final of the Football League Cup, and a final placing in the League table of 5th, with subsequent entry into the U.E.F.A. Cup is certainly a performance that we should not be ashamed of. However you may rest assured that we shall strive for even better results this coming season, particularly as it celebrates our 60th consecutive season in the 1st Division of the Football League. The results of our other teams can be found at the back of this report.

Turning to the Accounts, it can be seen that our gate receipts showed an increase of £533,624 a large proportion of which relates to our success in reaching the Final of the F.A. Cup and the Semi-Final of the League Cup. The expenditure on Players, Management and Staff was considerably higher this year but as has been explained on previous occasions, our Players' contracts etc., are directly related to success.

The profit from programmes, handbooks and ground advertising continues to provide a substantial contribution to the profits, the majority of this year's increase being from our ground advertising.

Our overall foothall income, therefore, showed an increase of £586,902 compared with the previous year's figure. Total expenditure for the year increased by £209,362.

As we pointed out last year, the Safety of Sports Ground Act 1975 would undoubtedly involve the Club in very considerable expenditure and in fact the charge in this year has amounted to £186,430. It can be seen, therefore, that the continued requirements of this Act have indeed been costly and we regret that even further charges will be incurred during this current season. However, on a slightly more optimistic note, we are happy to report that as a result of this work being undertaken, the capacity of the stadium has been maintained without reduction.

The net result, therefore, is an excess of Income over Expenditure of £187,449. After provision for Corporation Tax the retained profit amounts to £112,403. Your Directors do not recommend the payment of a dividend.

Under the provisions of Article 90 of the Articles of Association Sir Robert Bellinger retires by rotation and, being eligible, offers himself for re-election.

Under the provisions of Article 90 of the Articles of Association Mr. S. C. McIntyre retires by rotation and, being eligible, offers himself for re-election.

The Auditors, Messrs. Hope, Agar & Co., have expressed their willingness to continue in office.
