(B) inform the Registrar of Companies immediately on the conclusion of the said proposed litigation or any appeal therefrom or the conclusion of the claim by any other means

- (2) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall, pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006, change the name of the Company to 00428454 Limited
- (3) an Office Copy of the Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the Company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (4) the Registrar of Companies does advertise notice of this Order in her official name in the "London Gazette"

(5) the Claiman goes pay to the Registrar of Companies her costs of the said Applicate Fin 2649 agreed sum of £300-00

(6) the hearing fixed for the 5th September 2019 at 2:00 pm be vacated
