- (b) Creditscheme pledging to the Administrative Agent for the benefit of the Lenders all of its right, title and interest in certain securities held by Creditscheme (including certain shareholdings held by Creditscheme and inter-company loan notes outstanding to its benefit) for the purpose of securing the obligations of Creditscheme under the UK Subsidiary Guaranty in the terms of the UK Subsidiary Pledge Agreement dated as of 7 April 1997 among, inter alia, Creditscheme, Deedtask, TGL and TAHL (the "UK Subsidiary Pledge Agreement"); and
- Creditscheme granting security by way of fixed and floating charge over all its present and future material assets (other than real property), in each case whenever acquired and wherever located, for the obligations of Creditscheme pursuant to the UK Subsidiary Guaranty in the terms of the UK Security Agreement dated as of 7 April 1997 among, inter alia, Creditscheme, Deedtask, TGL and TAHL (the "UK Security Agreement").
