1 Accounting policies

The Financial Statements have been prepared on a going concern basis, under the historical costs convention and in compliance with United Kingdom Accounting Standards, including Financial Reporting Standard 102, "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland" ("FRS 102") and the Companies Act 2006.

The Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Reckitt Benckiser Group plc (the "Group"), a company registered in England and Wales, which has prepared publicly available consolidated accounts which include the Company.

a) General Information

SSL (MG) Polymers Limited is a company registered in England and Wales in 1964. The Company is subject to the Companies Act 2006. The address of the registered office is 103-105 Bath Road, Slough, Berkshire, SL1 3UH. The Company did not trade during the year.
