

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

- (a) BASIS OF ACCOUNTING
 The financial statements are prepared using the historical cost basis of accounting.
- (b) INCOME Income comprises grants and sundry income received during the period.
- (c) TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS

 Tangible fixed assets are stated in the balance sheet at cost less accumulated depreciation.
- (d) DEPRECIATION
 Depreciation is calculated to write off the cost of tangible fixed assets over their estimated useful lives on the following annual bases:
