NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. General information

Viridor Waste Wootton Limited is a company registered in the United Kingdom under the Companies Act 2006. The address of the registered office is Viridor House, Priory Bridge Road, Taunton, Somerset, TA1 1AP. The nature of the Company's operations and its principal activities are set out in the Directors' Report on page 1.

2. Principal accounting policies

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all the years presented.

(a) Basis of preparation

These financial statements have been prepared on the historical cost accounting basis and in accordance with international financial accounting standards ('IFRS') in conformity with the requirements of the Companies Act 2006. A summary of the principal accounting policies is set out below, together with an explanation where changes have been made to previous policies on the adoption of new accounting standards and interpretations in the year.

New or revised standards or interpretations which were mandatory for the first time in the year beginning 1 April 2020 did not have a material impact on the net assets or results of the Company.

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with IFRS requires the use of estimates and assumptions which affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Although these estimates are based on management's best assessment of the amounts, actual events or actions and results may ultimately differ from those estimates.

(b) Financial instruments

The Company classifies its financial instruments in the following categories:

i) Trade and other receivables

Trade and other receivables do not carry any interest and are initially recognised at fair value and subsequently at amortised cost using the effective interest method, less provision for impairment. A provision for impairment of trade and other receivables is established when there is objective evidence that the Company will not be able to collect all amounts due according to the original terms of the receivables.

ii) Trade payables

Trade payables are not interest bearing and are initially recognised at fair value and subsequently measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method.

(c) Share capital

Ordinary shares are classified as equity.
