'The Trustees may appoint a person (whether or not he be a member) as the Director for such time at such remuneration and upon such conditions as they may think fit and any Director so appointed shall be directly responsible to the Trustees through the Chairman for the management administration and conduct of the work of the Foundation and the implementation of its policy.
