FINAL REPORT TO CREDITORS ON THE ARRANGEMENT FROM THE DATE OF APPROVAL (29 JANUARY 1997) TO 25 NOVEMBER 2003

ABBEY DINGLE NURSING HOME LIMITED ("THE COMPANY") (UNDER A COMPANY VOULNTARY ARRANGEMENT)

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 As previously advise I was Appointed Supervisor of the above Arrangement on 29 January 1997. On 18 December 2003, I issued a Certificate of Compliance in the Arrangement and I write to provide my final report in this matter.

2. COMPLIANCE WITH THE ARRANGEMENT

2.1 I summarise below the major issues and the position in respect of each:

2.2 Payments into the Scheme Fund

- 2.2.1 The original proposal provided for the company to pay into the Scheme Fund monthly installments of £1,000, for a period of 60 months, until an amount of not less than £60,000 had been received.
- 2.2.3 The Company has paid all funds due and owing into the arrangement and all funds have now been disbursed. I therefore attach a copy of the Certificate of Compliance issued in respect of the arrangement.

3. CREDITORS OF THE ARRANGEMENT

3.1 Preferential Creditor

- 3.1.1 A Preferential claim totaling £18,927.94 was received and agreed from the Inland Revenue. The Inland Revenue were paid 100p in the £ as follows:
 - On 23 September 1999 a dividend of 60p in the £ in the sum of £11,356.76 was distributed to the Inland Revenue in respect of their preferential claim.
 - On 11 October 2001 a dividend of 40p in the £ in the sum of £7,571.18 was distributed to the Inland Revenue in respect of their preferential claim.

3.2 Unsecured Creditors

3.2.1 Twenty unsecured claims totaling £30,102.41 were received. A first and final dividend of 18.397p in the £ was distributed to unsecured creditors on 14 May 2003, in the sum of £6,865.73.

4. RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS

4.1.1 A copy of my Receipts and Payments Abstract is attached which has been reconciled.

5. COSTS OF THE ARRANGEMENT

5.1.1 The Nominees fee of £5,500 plus VAT has been paid. Supervisors fees of £20,623.75 plus VAT have been drawn in accordance with Official Receivers scale rates plus additional time costs approved on 24 March 2000.

6 SUPERVISOR'S CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

6.1.1 The Company has paid all funds due and owing into the arrangement and a Certificate of Compliance has been issued. I have now ceased to act as Supervisor of the arrangement.
