Accountant's Report to the Members on the Unaudited Accounts of Chesterfield Citizens Advice Bureau

I report on the accounts for the year ended 31 March 1998.

Respective responsibilities of management committee and reporting accountant

The charity's management committee is responsible for the preparation of the accounts and it considers that the company is exempt from an audit. It is my responsibility to carry out procedures designed to enable me to report my opinion.

Basis of opinion

My work was conducted in accordance with the Statement of Standards for Reporting Accountants and so my procedures consisted of comparing the accounts with the accounting records kept by the charity. These procedures provide only the assurance expressed in my opinion.

Opinion

In my opinion:

- a) the accounts are in agreement with the accounting records kept by the charity under section 221 of the Companies Act 1985;
- b) having regard to and on the basis of the information contained in those accounting records:
 - i) the accounts have been drawn up in the matter consistent with the provisions specified in section 249(6) of the Act; and
 - ii) the charity satisfies the requirements for exemption from an audit of the accounts for the year specified in sections 249A(4) of the Act and did not at any time within that year fall within any of the categories of companies not entitled to the exemption specified in section 249(1) (a)-(f).

The management committee confirm that:

- a) for the year in question the charity was entitled to exemption under subsection 91) of section 249A of the Companies Act 1985.
- b) no notice has been deposited under section 249B(2) in relation to its accounts for the financial year; and

 - ii) preparing accounts which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the charity as at the end of the financial year and of its surplus or deficit for the financial year in accordance with the requirement of section 226 and which otherwise comply with the requirements of the Act relating to accounts so far as applicable to the charity.

In preparing these abbreviated financial statements we have taken advantage of the exemptions conferred by section A of Pt 111 of Schedule 8 made under sections 246 and 247 of the Companies Act 1985 on the grounds that the charity is entitled to those exemptions as a small company.
