Statement of expenses incurred in the Period

1. Progress of the Administration in the Period



Work undertaken during the period

This report should be read in conjunction with the Joint Administrators' proposals dated 18 September 2018. We attach at **Appendix C** a schedule of work undertaken during the Period together with a summary of work still to be completed.

The Joint Administrators' proposals were approved on 4 October 2018 by creditors.

Attached at **Appendix E** are the receipts and payments accounts detailing transactions in both sterling and euros currencies for the period since our appointment as Joint Administrators.

Ongoing Operations

As previously advised, the business and assets were sold to Racing Point on 16 August 2018. $\label{eq:previously}$

Following the sale of the business and assets, we provided assistance to Racing Point to enable them to make critical payments to assist with the transfer of the business and assets of the Company in accordance with further assurance and assistance clauses contained with the sale and purchase agreement. This partially involved making certain payments to suppliers (for ongoing and future supplies) and the August 2018 salaries. Payment was made from funds provided by Racing Point.

We have also been liaising with Racing Point's solicitors in the transfer of leasehold premises.

Assistance continues to be provided where necessary.

Assigned Claims

Racing Point have undertaken a process of paying most trade creditors.

The rationale for this was to preserve trading relationships with suppliers and enable Racing Point to utilise critical services. This process was predicated on the completion of the assignment of trade creditor claims to Racing Point. We understand that Racing Point have now issued deeds of assignment to most trade creditors. Following a verification exercise the assignments were completed and the creditors paid by Racing Point

Tax matters

We have instructed accountants to bring the Company's tax affairs up to date and prepare the tax returns for the Administration trading period. We are in dialogue with our accountants to finalise these returns.

There will be a capital gain liability arising on the sale of the Company's business and assets which will be settled from the estate as an expense of the Administration.

Legal claims by creditors

We continue to deal with and progress the various legal claims brought against the Company.

As previously advised we have received a claim of approximately £10 million as commission for the introduction of a sponsor. This claim is presently scheduled for trial in July 2019 and work continues with the Company's solicitors ahead of the matter either being settled or proceeding to trial.

A further claim for commission for introducing a sponsor of approximately £8 million, is also being reviewed in conjunction with the Company's solicitors.

Discussions continue in relation to a claim for approximately £3 million relating to the introduction of an interested party that was seeking to acquire the Company prior to Administration.

1. Progress of the Administration in the Period



Other Claims

The position with the prospective claims from both BWT and OIH as referenced in the Joint Administrators' proposals of 18 September 2018 continue to be monitored. There are no material matters to report at the time of issuing this report.

Recovery action by Administrators

We have continued to liaise with the Company's solicitors in relation to a claim for recovery of monies relating to a cancelled sponsorship agreement. This claim is at an early stage and should it proceed to trial, that would unlikely occur before late 2020/early 2021.

Challenge to the sale process

A further litigation matter has arisen since the publication of the Joint Administrators Proposals. On 27 September 2018 proceedings were issued against the Joint Administrators by PJSC Uralkali. The claim relates to the sale of the Company's assets to Racing Point with the claimants seeking a monetary damages award. The Joint Administrators are defending the proceedings and have instructed solicitors to act for them in this respect. A defence was filed at Court on 29 October 2018.

The claim is at an early stage and it is therefore not yet clear when the trial will take place but will not occur until 2020 at the earliest.

Investigations

Part of our duties include carrying out proportionate investigations into what assets the Company has, including any potential claims against directors or other parties, and what recoveries could be made.

We have taken electronic scans of all of the Company's electronic records and reviewed the Company's physical books & records and accounting information. Emails

and the financial systems have been reviewed, and our forensic data analysis team have sought to build up a picture of the Company's affairs in the lead up to insolvency. This took a significant amount of time and this is reflected in our time records at **Appendix C**.

We have complied with the obligations to provide information to the Insolvency Service on the conduct of the directors and continue to review the position in light of our findings.

At this time, no statement of affairs has been completed by the directors.

Extension to the initial period of appointment

Given the timings of the various litigation processes, it is probable that an extension of the Administration will be required prior to the Company entering liquidation.

Anticipated exit strategy

We anticipate the Company will move into creditors voluntary liquidation prior to the expiry of the Administration which is in line with our approved proposals.

2. Estimated Outcome for the creditors



The estimated outcome for creditors was set out in the Joint Administrators' proposals,

Outcome for the secured creditors

There were no secured creditors registered at Companies House.

Outcome for the preferential creditors

There are no preferential creditors as following the sale of the business and assets all employees were transferred under TUPE (Transfer of Undertakings (Protection of Employment) (Amendment) Regulations 2014) to Racing Point.

Outcome for the unsecured creditors

Based on the current position we anticipate there will be sufficient funds to repay creditors in full and make a dividend distribution to OIH as the shareholder from the residual funds. A distribution will be paid following the Company being placed into liquidation.

Prescribed Part

A prescribed part is not appropriate because there is no holder of a floating charge.

Joint Administrators' remuneration, disbursements, expenses and pre-appointment costs



Joint Administrators' remuneration

Following the circulation of the Joint Administrators' proposals the creditors passed the following resolutions that the Joint Administrators' remuneration be calculated as follows:

Remuneration charged on a time costs basis

Time incurred in dealing with investigations and creditors (to include the disputed creditor legal claims) against the Company be charged by reference to time incurred. This was capped at £500,220 plus VAT.

Remuneration charged on a percentage of successful claims

Remuneration in dealing with legal claims brought by the Company against third parties be fixed at 15% of gross realisations from successful claims. No fees have been drawn to date on this basis.

Remuneration charged as a set amount

Remuneration be charged as a fixed fee in respect of the sale of business and assets, statutory matters and other general categories of work. This was agreed at £2,025,000 excluding VAT.

Details of remuneration charged during the period of the report are set out in the statement of expenses attached.

A breakdown of our time costs incurred during the period of this report is attached at **Appendix D.** The remuneration anticipated to be recovered by the Joint Administrators based on time costs, is likely to exceed the sum provided in the fees estimate circulated to creditors with our proposals. This is due to the amount of time incurred in dealing with the various legal claim against the Company including the claim challenging the sale process and our legal costs in investigating and obtaining evidence to defend these.

The Joint Administrators are unable to draw fees based on time costs exceeding the total amount set out in the fee estimate without further approval of the creditors.

Increase in fee cap

It is now proposed that the cap on the time incurred in dealing with investigations and creditors (to include the disputed creditor legal claims) against the Company, which is charged by reference to time incurred, is increased to £1,000,345. This is set out in the revised fee estimate attached at **Appendix D.** During the period it has become evident that there is substantial further work to be carried out in bringing the various claims to a satisfactory conclusion. This is particularly the case if (as it seems likely) any of the claims are not resolved until 2020. This is in the interests of the creditors and shareholders as the dismissal of claims will (based on current information) secure the full return to unsecured creditors and enable a return to shareholders.

3. Joint Administrators' remuneration, disbursements, expenses and pre-appointment costs



As previously advised, there is a significant uncertainty in the time that is required to deal with the required investigations and the legal claims to ensure that they are dealt with appropriately.

The time charged is based on computerised records capturing time charged by myself and my staff in dealing with the conduct of those aspects of the case being charged on a time cost basis. Matters dealt with during the assignment are dealt with by different members of staff depending on the level of complexity and the experience required. Time is charged to the case in units of six minutes. Charge-out rates are based on individual expertise, qualification and grade. The costs of the firm's support staff are not directly charged to the estate unless dealing with directly identifiable case specific matters.

Charge out rates are reviewed at least annually, details of FRP's charge out rates are included at **Appendix C**.

Joint Administrators' disbursements

The Joint Administrators' disbursements are a recharge of actual costs incurred by the Joint Administrators on behalf of the Company. Mileage payments made for expenses relating to the use of private vehicles for business travel, which is directly attributable to the insolvency estate, are paid by FRP Advisory at the HMRC approved mileage rate prevailing at the time the mileage was incurred. Details of disbursements incurred during the period of this report are set out in **Appendix D**.

Joint Administrators' expenses

An estimate of the Joint Administrators' expenses was set out in the Joint Administrators' proposals. We attach at **Appendix F** a statement of expenses that have been incurred during the period covered by this report. It is currently expected that the expenses incurred or anticipated to be incurred are not likely to exceed the details previously provided

Creditors have a right to request further information from the Administrators and further have a right to challenge the Administrators' remuneration and other expenses, which are first disclosed in this report, under the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules. (For ease of reference these are the expenses incurred in the reporting period as set out in **Appendix F** only). Joint Administrators' pre-appointment costs

Details of the pre-appointment costs incurred by the Joint Administrators were included in the Joint Administrators' proposals. These costs are an expense of the administration and were approved by creditors on 4 October 2018. Our costs and disbursements of £47,357 and £361 respectively and legal costs of £29,451 were paid on 9 October 2018.
