Pursuant to Chapter 2 of Part 13 of the Companies Act 2006, the directors of the Company propose that the following resolutions are passed as special resolutions (the "Resolutions")

SPECIAL RESOLUTIONS

1 **THAT** pursuant to section 641(1)(a) of the Companies Act 2006, (i) the authorised and issued share capital of the Company be reduced from £2 to £1 by cancelling and extinguishing one of the previously existing two ordinary shares of £1 each in issue and that the total authorised and issued share capital of the Company now be one ordinary share of £1 registered in the name of Mansfield Brewery Trading Limited, and (ii) the sum of £1 be credited to the Company's distributable reserves

2 **THAT** the memorandum of association of the Company be amended to read as follows

"The authorised share capital of the Company is £1 comprised of 1 ordinary share of £1 "
