## AUDITORS' REPORT ON ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS

# Auditors' report to the director of Carroll Insurance Group Limited pursuant to paragraph 24 of Schedule 8 to the Companies Act 1985

We have examined the abbreviated accounts on pages 3 and 4 together with the annual accounts of Carroll Insurance Group Limited prepared under Section 226 of the Companies Act 1985 for the year ended 30th November 1995.

# Respective responsibilities of director and auditors

The director is responsible for preparing the abbreviated accounts in accordance with Schedule 8 to the Companies Act 1985. It is our responsibility to form an independent opinion as to the company's entitlement to the exemptions claimed in the director's statement on page 3 and whether they have been properly prepared in accordance with that Schedule.

#### Basis of opinion

We have carried out the procedures we considered necessary to confirm, by reference to the audited accounts, that the company is entitled to the exemptions and that the abbreviated accounts have been properly prepared from those accounts. The scope of our work for the purpose of this report does not include examining or dealing with events after the date of our report on the full accounts.

# Opinion

In our opinion the company is entitled under Sections 246, 247 and 249 of the Companies Act 1985 to the exemptions conferred by Section A of Part III of Schedule 8 to that Act in respect of the year ended 30th November 1995 and the abbreviated accounts on pages 3 and 4 have been properly prepared in accordance with that Schedule.

#### Other information

On 25 September 1996 we reported, as auditors of Carroll Insurance Group Limited, to the members on the annual accounts prepared under Section 226 of the Companies Act 1985 for the year ended 30th November 1995 and our audit report was as follows:
