CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE

LIFE SKILLS

The Living Skills programme was originally produced as part of the Carmarthenshire Rural Development Plan. The scheme offers support to parents and baby and child minders with a focus on communication, language, literacy and play through healthy eating and keeping fit. The project is a natural progression to Language and Play and Numeracy and Play focusing on the following core features; -

- Eating healthily and keeping fit
- The Food Plate - 5 a day
- Healthy Cooking in and out of home
- Food dates and Food labels
- Meals, Snacks and Food Tasting
- Looking after our body

The programme's aim:-

- Improve language development 0-3 years
- Encourage interaction between parents and young children
- Encourage parents to share books and stories with babies and young children
- Develop the understanding and confidence of parents
- Laying the foundation for lifelong learning

Care Clubs

Menter Cwm Gwendraeth Elli co-ordinates and manages registered Care Clubs which meet from 3:00 to 6:00 pm across the Gwendraeth Valley area and Llanelli. The clubs are inspected by the Care and Social Services Inspectorate Wales and have received very honourable reports.

Joio-Fun Clubs

A series of 10 Welsh Language Joio and Fun Clubs are provided after School across the Gwendraeth Valley and Llanelli District areas. These Clubs offer an hour and a half of specific activities after school and expand the opportunities for 4 - 11-year-olds to socialise through the medium of Welsh after school.

Junior and Youth Theatre

The theatre offers a service for 4 - 11-year-olds and 11 - 18-year-olds, meeting weekly during term time. The team of experienced directors offers numerous experiences in theatre and performance. During the year the fruits of the weekly workshops were presented in theatrical performances. There were very fun performances, and this was a further opportunity to raise the profile of the company's work and the talent of the young people.

Language Awareness

As the nature of our work has had to change over this year, virtual language awareness sessions are offered to all primary and secondary schools in the Gwendraeth Valley and Llanelli, and also to Coleg Sir Gar's Graig Campus. The aim of these sessions is to raise awareness of the history of the language, important events that have affected the Welsh language and how the language has inspired individuals in their career e.g., Nigel Owens and Alex Jones. The crucial message is that people need to use the language, whatever kind of Welsh they speak.

Covid Capsule

The Covid Capsule has been one of the highlights of MCGE during the period. The Covid Capsule was created for primary age children first, with television on radio showing an interest in the pack. The pack reached over 40,000 people on the Menter's social media. The pack was specifically to give individuals the opportunity to look back at this strange time. Following the success of the capsule, a suitable one was created for pre-school-age children and its parents and for young people / adults.

Digital

As everyone has had to adapt a way of working because of the current situation, a weekly timetable is being created targeting people of all ages and all linguistic abilities, children and young people, learners, mother and baby, schools, only to list some. We have taken advantage of the opportunity to develop a website for the Cwtsh as we have had to close for a while following Welsh Government guidance. The website continues to develop. Plant y Cwm have also developed an online booking system for the Menter's after school clubs. It is a secure system, which allows us to monitor figures during this strange time.

Reading Club

The Covid Reading Club was created for adults over lockdown and has been a successful project. 10 individuals are part of the group and have interesting discussions about current books. The individuals meet weekly reading novels, short stories, autobiography and have discussions in the wake of the themes that arise. This is a great way to socialise and have a bit of fun. The aim of the group is to meet face to face regularly when guidance allows.

Ownzone

Menter Cwm Gwendraeth Elli manages the Ownzone scheme at Ysgol Dyffryn Amman. Ownzone's important role is to create effective partnerships that can help children and young people between the ages of ten and fourteen. Together and working very closely with the School, we have been creating external partnerships for the project.

Ownzone gives students the opportunity to contribute to, and organise, activity planning and gain ownership of what is happening. The young people will receive the following:

- An opportunity to develop key skills and thinking skills by having their say on what is happening
- Develop their self-confidence and self-esteem
- Feel positive about school, and be motivated to learn
- Broadening horizons

Adfer Energy Redress

Adfer Energy Redress offers support to the people of Carmarthenshire to reduce the heating costs of their homes and reduce Fuel Poverty. Fuel Poverty affects thousands of households across Wales and has a negative impact on health, contributing to ill health and mortality over the Winter. Adfer Energy Redress will help vulnerable people. It will also empower people to take positive action in communities themselves, in response to the increase in the cost of heating homes—a trend that is of considerable concern to many with the increase in current energy cost. The Energy Redress Recovery officer works free of charge with individuals to save energy costs in the home and reduce energy debt. The officer will be campaigning across Carmarthenshire with headway shows and one-to-one energy surgeries and a specific focus. Fuel poverty is highest in rural areas that do not have access to the Gas grid. Adfer Energy Redress welcomes the opportunity to work with local housing organisations and support groups free of charge.

LIFELONG LEARNING

Learners. Learning Welsh in the Community

Over the years a large number of people have ventured into Welsh for Adults Education classes across Llanelli and the Gwendraeth Valley, and the Welsh language community is very grateful to them for their commitment and perseverance.

The Welsh Government's Strategy "A Million Speakers" is dependent on creating new speakers and encouraging them to use the language on the ground for the benefit of all. Working with learners is key to the continuity of the language and as Menter Iaith, we have prioritised efforts to help these learners 'transition', that is to go from being pure learners to being natural speakers. To do this, we have established varied sessions to help learners understand and come to speak Welsh which is very similar to the language used by local people.

Clwb Croeso sessions are run for people who are new to the area and to the Welsh language, and who want to learn to speak some of the Welsh language in order to understand more of what is going on around them. The Clybiau Croeso are provided in Llandyfaelog, Cross Hands, Llanelli, Pontyberem, Pum Heol, Ffwrnes a Thrimaran. We also provide sessions for learners, or local people who have some grasp of the Welsh language but are scared to use it in situations out of the class.

These Clwb Clubs place the emphasis on enjoyment through the medium of Welsh and an opportunity to socialise using the Welsh language used locally. As a result of these sessions, learners go on to attend a large number of formal and informal events run by the Menter, but also by other community groups.

Menter Cwm Gwendraeth Elli works closely with learners in the Gwendraeth Valley area and Llanelli. This includes holding discussion sessions and working with learners.

Dim Clem Quiz

Cwis Dim Clem is a project for year 6 children of The Gwendraeth Valley and Llanelli primary schools. The quiz contains several different rounds that raise awareness of the Welsh language. There are several rounds which lead to the final round. Following the success of the Quiz, it is now a regional project and has grown to be national.

Meals on Wheels

The Meals on Wheels service is offered to residents of the Gwendraeth Valley twice a week. These residents have a hot meal, two courses provided at the home. This service is vital to the people who are house-bound. Thank you to the volunteers for their support in distributing the packed lunches. These individuals also appreciate seeing a familiar face on a weekly basis.

Christian Project

A Christian project was established in the Gwendraeth Valley to promote young people's access and understanding to Christian attitudes. Our intention is to create a network of activities in schools and youth clubs creating a Christian atmosphere.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2021

1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Menter Cwm Gwendraeth Elli Limited is a registered charity and private company limited by guarantee incorporated in Wales within the United Kingdom. The registered office is 11-15 Coalbrook Road, Pontyberem, Llanelli, Sir Gaerfyrddin, SAIS SHU.

The financial statements are presented in pounds sterling (£).

2 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of accounting

The company prepares its financial statements on the basis of historical cost accounting.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section IA "Small Companies" of Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the United Kingdom and republic of The Republic of Wales" and the Companies Act 2006.

Preparing the accounts on the basis of viability

On balance sheet, Menter Cwm Gwendraeth Elli has a deficit of £1,379,544 (2020: £1,415,538). This is due to the introduction, on 1 April 2015, of the associated liability and the Defined Pension and Benefits Scheme. The Pension Deficit is a long-term liability, and the charity is in a position to meet all its current obligations. The short-term liability of the pension deficit is recognised by the Trustees, and they are in a position to meet all these implications. The Trustees believe that, on this basis, the charity is a going concern and viable business.

Pension Costs

Menter Cwm Gwendraeth Elli operates defined pension and benefits within the Dyfed Pension Fund. Following the adoption of FRS 102 in April 2015, this deficit is shown in full on the Balance Sheet.

Turnover

Turnover represents the value of goods and services provided during the year.

Fixed Assets and Depreciation

The value of fixed assets is noted in the balance-sheet at cost less depreciation. The cost of fixed assets is written off in equal annual instalments over their deemed useful life as follows: -

Furniture and Equipment-15%

Assets purchased via lease agreements are considered capital assets and are depreciated at the above rates.

Grants

Grants are credited to income in accordance with the periods to which they relate.

RISK ASSESSMENT

The company has considered and reviewed all risks that may affect the charity. This process covered not only the financial situation but also strategic and circumstantial considerations. Systems have been put in place to withstand every risk of the type noted as part of this process.

Financial instruments

The financial instruments not tied to market movements include commercial and other debtors, money and the equivalent of money, commercial creditors and other creditors.

Except where otherwise stated, the values of the company's financial assets and commitments are fair estimates.

Use of Profit

The company's profit is used to create a general reserve fund with a view to ensuring the company's continuance and development on a share's basis and in accordance with methods recommended by the Management Committee and approved by the Annual General Meeting

Guarantor

Each member's liability is restricted to a maximum of £1. This liability is annulled one year following termination of membership.
