Directors' and Trustees Report for the year ended 5 April 2000

The directors and trustees present their report and the financial statements for the period ended 5 April 2000.

Objects and Principal Activities of the Charity

The Charity is constituted as a Company limited by guarantee, and is therefore governed by a memorandum and articles of association.

The principal activities of the charity are to advise and assist persons with alcohol or drug related or connected personal problems in overcoming those problems; to assist the families and dependants of such persons and to advance the education of the general public with the misuse of drugs, alcohol and other substances.

Development, Activities and Achievements

The past year has been an exciting one for Cyswllt Ceredigion Contact. We now have in place our new Programme Co-ordinator, who has brought fresh ideas and inspiration to the organisation. In addition, towards the end of the financial year, we were awarded £197,047 from the National Lotteries Charity Board to enable us to expand our existing services into other areas of Ceredigion. These two factors have afforded Cyswllt the stability it needs to further its work in the community and to continue to develop an effective treatment programme that reaches all who need it.

Notes to the Accounts for the year ended 5 April 2000

1. Accounting Policies

1.1. Basis of preparation of accounts

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and include the results of the charity's operations which are described in the Directors' and Trustees' Report and all of which are continuing.

The accounts have been prepared in compliance with Statement of Recommended Practice on Charity Accounts.

The charity has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard No. 1 from the requirement to produce a cashflow statement.

1.2. Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation.

Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases:

1.3. Income

Voluntary income and donations are accounted for as received by the charity.

1.4. Operating leases

Rentals applicable to operating leases where substantially all the benefits and risks of ownership remain with the lessor are reflected in the Statement of Financial Activities as incurred.

1.5. Expenditure on management and administration of the charity

Administration expenditure includes all expenditure not directly related to the charitable activities.

2. Grants received

Grants received towards capital expenditure have been credited to a restricted fund against which the depreciation of the equipment will be charged.

Grants towards revenue expenditure are credited to a restricted fund and released as the expenditure is incurred.
