The Purchaser entered into a Sale and Purchase Agreement on 17 August 2001 (the "Agreement"). On the same day, the Company entered into Service Agreements with its employees (the "Service Agreements") whereby the Company agreed to pay cash bonuses to its employees in lieu of the employees' entitlement to proceeds of sale of the Company or, alternatively, the shareholdings in the Company. This ensured that the Purchaser received a 100% shareholding in the Company on completion of the Agreement.

The principal terms on which the assistance will be given are:

On the second anniversary of completion of the Agreement, the Company is to pay a total amount of £58,643.40 pro rata to the employees, some of whom were entitled to shares in the Company, some of whom were entitled to proceeds of sale in the Company. The employees waived the rights to the above by executing waiver letters in consideration of them receiving cash bonuses on the terms set out in the Agreement and the Service Agreements. The Purchaser is to put the Company in funds prior to the payment of the cash bonuses so as to achieve no reduction in the net asset value of the Company. The funds injected into the Company by the Purchaser will be grossed up to reflect the employer's National Insurance Contributions payable on the amount of the bonus of £58,643.40. The whitewash procedure will apply to the amount of £58,643.40 grossed up to include the employer's NIC liability.
