We are writing to you with our interim report on the progress of the administration.¹

The asset realisations are proceeding satisfactorily although we still have some work to do to finalise the debtors and retentions.

The statement of affairs indicated that assets available for unsecured creditors would be £372,288. We have realised £255,129 to date. You can see a full breakdown of this sum in the accompanying receipts and payments account (Appendix I) .

As previously reported, we anticipate a return to unsecured creditors. Our best estimate, which will principally be influenced by the outcome of our negotiations with debtors, is that there will be a dividend of 40-50%.

The administration will last up to 12 months (ie up to 15 March 2006). After that, the Company will go into Creditors Voluntary Liquidation so that creditors claims can be agreed and funds distributed. We will report further on the timing of the liquidation once the position with Clarks has been finalised.

We are collating creditors claims now, so that an early distribution can be paid in the liquidation. If you have not already done so, please let us have your claim as soon as possible.

Book Debts

Of the amount realised, £219,070 is attributable to contract debtors and work in progress as at the date of our appointment. There is a further £158,554, which may be collected.

Of this, Clarks Shoes represents £71,435 in respect of the refurbishment of their outlets. All these contracts are now out of their maintenance period and the majority of the snagging work has been, or will shortly be, completed. However, there remain a number of issues with Clarks that we hope to resolve in the next few weeks.

We still await settlement of work done in respect of a customer's insurance claim (£36,000) following a flood, despite our efforts to agree the amount to be paid.

In addition, there are other, smaller and contentious amounts due from a number of, principally private, clients that are being dealt with by my quantity surveyors.

Other assets

Our agents realised the other assets by tender sale at the values shown on the receipts and payments account.
