MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION OF URBAN PARTNERSHIP GROUP



1. The name of the Company (hereinafter called "the Company") is URBAN Partnership Group.
2. The registered office of the Company shall be situated in England and Wales.
3. The objects for which the Company is established are:-
 - (a) to facilitate and extend community involvement in the economic, social and environmental regeneration of those Wards and areas in the immediate vicinity, within the Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham, which are eligible for, or in receipt of SRB or similar national Regeneration Funding, as shown in the schedule to this Memorandum (hereinafter called "the area of benefit").
 - (b) to promote capacity-building in the area of benefit, allowing local people to develop the skills and knowledge to participate fully in the community and economic activities.
 - (c) to promote, for the benefit of the inhabitants of the area of benefit and its immediate environs, without distinction of age, sex, political, religious or other option, by associating the statutory authorities, businesses and individuals in a common effort to advance education and to provide facilities in the interests of social welfare, health, housing, recreation and leisure time occupation and to foster a community spirit for the achievement of these and any other charitable objects.
1. The Company shall have the following powers exercisable in furtherance of its said objects, but not further or otherwise, namely:
 - (a) to establish or to secure the establishment of a centre or centres and to maintain or to co-operate with any statutory authority or authorities or voluntary organisations in the maintenance and/or management of such centres.
 - (b) raise funds, to invite and receive contributions and to provide a focus for fundraising and project development, in order to implement initiatives related to the above.
 - (c) to act as a representative body for local interests in specific regeneration programmes where this is felt to be appropriate by the other partners in such
