ORDER

BEFORE DISTRICT JUDGE GOLDBERG ON 23 OCTOBER 2020

UPON THE APPLICATION of Daryl Warwick, Michael Christian Kienlen and Robert David Adamson dated

AND UPON READING the Application of the Applicants, the Witness Statements and the papers on the court file.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Each of the County Court cases listed in the schedule attached to this order (the "**Schedule**") be transferred to the High Court Division for the purpose only of making this Order.
2. Immediately upon this Order taking effect, the County Court cases listed in the Schedule be transferred back to the County Court.
3. Mark Nicholas Ranson (the "**outgoing office-holder**") be removed from office in respect of each of the cases listed in the Schedule (the "**block transfer cases**") from the date of this Order.
4. Daryl Warwick, Robert David Adamson, and Michael Christian Kienlen ("**the replacement office-holders**") be appointed as joint replacement office-holders in respect of each of the block transfer cases listed in the schedule from the date of this order.

5. The creditors in each of the block transfer cases be notified of this Order by the publishing in the Gazette one composite notice relating to all new appointments effected hereby and shall file any appropriate notices in respect of the outgoing office-holder's resignation and those appointments with the Registrar of Companies and the Department for Business, Innovation and Skills (Insolvency Service) as appropriate within 28 days.
6. Any creditor, or, in the case of any members' voluntary liquidation, any member, in respect of any of the companies or persons listed in the Schedule who has an objection to this Order shall have 14 days from the date of the notice placed in the Gazette to apply to Court to set aside or vary the terms of this Order. Such Application shall not affect the transfer of the block transfer cases listed in the Schedule until further or other Order by the Court.
7. The replacement office-holders shall give notice to the Secretary of State and the Registrar of Companies in respect of the insolvency proceedings listed in the Schedule of the terms of this Order as soon as reasonably practicable.
8. Compliance with Rule 12.38(3) of the Rules is varied so that lodging a certified copy of this Order, once sealed, with each Court is deemed to be compliant with that Rule.
9. Nothing in this Order shall release the outgoing office-holder from any obligation to give and file notices in respect of his removal under this order in respect of the block transfer cases listed in the Schedule.
10. The outgoing office-holder shall be granted his release as office-holder for the cases listed in the Schedule, 21 days after publication in the Gazette referred to above, save that such release may be subject to further Order in the event of an Application by any creditor or member under paragraph 6 of this order for the specific case subject to that Application.
11. With regard to the administration appointments included in the Schedule attached, this Application is made pursuant to paragraph 95 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986.
12. The costs of this Application shall be paid as an expense and shall be apportioned equally between each of the block transfer cases save in respect of the administration cases, so that the estate of each block transfer case shall bear an equal proportion of the costs.
13. The costs of this Application in respect of the administration cases detailed in the Schedule are to be paid as an expense of the administration.
14. Service of Notice of the Application upon the Respondent be dispensed with.
15. The replacement office holders may exercise any of the powers conferred on them by the Insolvency Act 1986 jointly or individually, any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done jointly may be done by either of them and no functions are required to be undertaken by any replacement office holders acting together in respect of each of the cases listed in the Schedule. Nor is any function specifically the responsibility of either office holder.


