The declaration of solvency, sworn by the directors prior to the commencement of the liquidation, showed cash at bank of £205,535.84, an inter-company debt of £418,191.67 due from Myonic GmbH, the Company's sole shareholder and a trade debtor of £18.22. It also showed a trade creditor of £361.73.

After the declaration of solvency was signed and prior to the Company going into liquidation, the cash and trade debtor balances were transferred to the sole shareholder increasing the inter-company debt to £638,236.04. The trade creditor was also settled prior to the Company going into liquidation.

Outstanding payments, totalling £2,523.80, due to HMRC in respect of PAYE and Class 1 NICs plus statutory interest were settled by Myonic GmbH on behalf of the Company during the year. The inter-company debt will be adjusted accordingly and will be reconciled with Myonic GmbH before the Joint Liquidators distribute the surplus debt to Myonic GmbH.

The Company had no known creditors. Notices to creditors to prove their claims in the liquidation were advertised in The London Gazette and The Times on 17 December 2015. No creditors were forthcoming as a result of these advertisements.

Tax

All outstanding corporation tax matters were handled by KPMG Tax, who prepared and submitted the outstanding corporation tax returns to HM Revenue & Customs ('HMRC').

At the request of the Joint Liquidators, HMRC subsequently confirmed that the Company had no outstanding corporation tax returns or liabilities, that it would not raise enquiries into any pre or post liquidation periods and that it had no objection to the Joint Liquidators taking steps to bring the liquidation to a conclusion.

A similar assurance has been sought and is awaited from HMRC in respect of PAYE and VAT.

Distributions

No distributions were made during the year.

Joint Liquidators' remuneration and expenses

A written resolution was passed on 4 December 2015 that the remuneration of the Joint Liquidators be fixed at their normal charging rates according to the time properly spent by them and members of their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up of the Company.

In the event, the Joint Liquidators' remuneration and expenses are being paid by another group company, Myonic GmbH, and therefore no detailed analysis is included in this report. The Joint Liquidators' remuneration to date has been £8,477.50, and they will bill for their additional time costs, as appropriate, prior to the closure of the liquidation.

Closure

There has been some delay in HMRC allocating the PAYE and Class 1 NICs payments correctly. They have advised that once this has been done, they will provide their assurance in respect to PAYE and VAT as outlined above. Once received, the Joint Liquidators will proceed to conclude the liquidation.
