REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES

The Trustees submit their report and financial statement for the year to 31 December 2019.

Incorporation

The company was incorporated as a Private Limited Company on 22nd May 1998 and is limited by guarantee and does not have a share capital. The word "Limited" is not included in the registered name.

Charitable Status

The Charity Commission registered the company as a charity on 14th August 1998

Principle Activity

The objectives of the company are to preserve for the benefit of the villagers of the Ecclesiastical Parish of Ayot St Lawrence in the County of Hertfordshire and the nation at large, The Old Church of St Lawrence, Ayot St Lawrence and its Churchyard.

Trustees' Responsibilities in Relation to the Financial Statements

Company Law requires the Trustees to prepare financial statements for each financial period that give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the Company and of the financial result for that period. In preparing those financial statements, the Trustees are required to select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently, making judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent, state whether applicable accounting standards have been followed, subject to any material departures disclosed and explained in the financial statements and prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis, unless it is inappropriate to presume that the Company will continue in business.

The Trustees are responsible for keeping proper accounting records that disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the Company and to enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act of 2006. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Company and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud or other irregularities.

REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES (continued)

Background

The Old Church of St Lawrence and its Churchyard had for many years been in the ownership of Ian N R Shields, a member of the Ames Family. He was willing to donate the property for the benefit of the village. Mr Daniel Desmond of Bride Hall, Ayot St Lawrence expressed a wish to support the stabilisation project by making a significant donation. It was subsequently arranged that:

- Daniel Desmond Ayot Limited would acquire the freehold title to the property.
- In consideration for the acquisition of freehold title:
 - O Daniel Desmond Ayot Limited would grant a 125-year lease to The Ayot St Lawrence Preservation Trust ("The Preservation Trust") at a peppercorn rent and would also donate £17,000 to The Preservation Trust. Furthermore, Daniel Desmond Ayot Limited agreed to pay The Preservation Trust the sum of £2,000 per annum in advance for ten years commencing in April 1999 to cover maintenance and other costs.

Work commenced on the Old Church stabilisation project in April 1999 and was substantially completed by the end of 2000.

The total expenditure on the stabilisation project, including the sum of £14,810 expended by the Ayot St Lawrence Society, "The Society", prior to the formation of the Charitable Company was £236,851. Grants towards this expenditure were made by:

Review of the Year

No major work was performed on the structure of the Old Church. Minor maintenance to control growth of invasive weeds was performed in May. In July topple testing and stabilisation of several gravestones and repair of a stone cross was undertaken by the Kimpton Bench Working Party. The Trust extends its thanks to the team for the excellent work undertaken voluntarily.

An outdoor service in celebration of animals that share their lives with us was held in August.

The 10-year agreement with Daniel Desmond Ayot Limited to provide funds to cover maintenance costs expired in 2008. Since the balance of funds held by the Trust and donations from the public via the collection box were felt to be sufficient to cover costs for the year, Daniel Desmond Ayot Limited was not approached for further support.

Trustees

The trustees listed on the front page are not remunerated for their services and have served throughout the year.

Independent Examination of the Accounts

The trustees are advised there is no requirement for an audit or independent examination of the company's accounts and accordingly no appointments have been made. Accounting advice is received from the accountants to the company as appropriate.

- 4. Leasehold Property The Trust has a long-term lease of The Old Church of St Lawrence, Ayot St Lawrence and its Churchyard. The lease is for 125 years from April 1999 at a peppercorn rent. A nominal value of £1 has been ascribed to the property for accounts purposes.
