ORDER

UPON THE PETITION (the "Petition") dated 26 May 2017 of Sun Yao (the "creditor"), a creditor of Euro Forex Investment Limited

AND UPON HEARING Counsel for the creditor

AND UPON READING the Petition and the written evidence filed

AND UPON THERE BEING no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to the relief sought by the Petition

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 5. The Company be wound up by the Court under the provisions of the Insolvency Act 1986.
