#### 1. Introduction

- 1.1 Edward Bines and Benjamin Wiles of Kroll were appointed Joint Liquidators of the Company on the Appointment Date, by resolution of the Member.
- 1.2 The purpose of this report is to provide the Member with details of the progress of the liquidation for the Reporting Period.

## 2. Progress of the Liquidation

2.1 The manner in which the affairs and business of the Company have been managed in the Reporting Period are set out below.

#### **Asset Realisations**

2.2 Please refer to the Previous Report for more information on asset realisations that have occurred in the previous reporting periods.

#### Intercompany Receivable

2.3 The intercompany receivable balance due from AOI is currently £5,141,768. The table below provides a reconciliation in the movement of the intercompany receivable balance in the Reporting Period:

- 2.4 The liquidators requested that AOI pay £300,000 into the liquidation estate in the Reporting Period to provide sufficient liquidity to enable them to make payments in relation to the software licence renewal (referred to in 2.11 below) and to HMRC in relation to corporation tax liabilities (referred to in 2.7 below).
- 2.5 The final AOI intercompany receivable position will be distributed to the Member at the conclusion of the liquidation.



#### Tax Matters

#### **Corporation Tax**

- 2.6 The Company's tax advisors have filed a Corporation Tax return during the Reporting Period covering the second year of the liquidation, being the year ended 6 July 2022.
- 2.7 During the Reporting Period, in addition to other immaterial costs, an advance payment of £115,000 has been paid to HMRC in relation to anticipated Corporation Tax on interest accrued on the intercompany receivable in the third year of the liquidation.
- 2.8 As previously reported, HMRC have issued tax enquiry notices in relation to filed Corporation Tax returns for the period 1 January 2018 to 26 November 2018. The Joint Liquidators are working with AOI and its tax advisors in dealing with the ongoing tax enquiry.

#### VAT

2.9 All outstanding pre-liquidation VAT returns have been filed.

#### Other Matters

2.10 The Joint Liquidators will request the necessary tax clearances from HMRC once HMRC's tax enquiry has been completed. Once tax clearances have been received steps will be taken to conclude the Liquidation.

#### Creditors

#### Software Licence Renewal

2.11 An invoice from Oracle Corporation UK Limited was paid in relation to the 2023 annual renewal of the Company's licence for the use of enterprise resource planning software. The contract remains in the name of the Company and is currently being renewed on an annual basis as it holds key financial information pertaining to the Company.

#### Distribution to the Member

- 2.12 A second capital distribution of £17,685,000 was declared to the Member on 15 June 2023.
- 2.13 A further distribution, consisting of the remaining AOI intercompany receivable and cash held in the liquidation estate, will be made at the end of the liquidation upon receipt of HMRC tax clearances.
- 2.14 An update will be provided in the next report to members, which in accordance with insolvency statute will be issued at the sooner of the conclusion of the liquidation or the next anniversary of the liquidation.



#### 3. Joint Liquidators' Costs and Expenses

- 3.1 A written resolution was passed on 7 July 2020 that the remuneration of the Joint Liquidators be fixed at their charging rates accordingly to the time properly spent by them and members of their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up of the Company.
- 3.2 I attach as Appendix 2, a schedule summarising the Joint Liquidators' time costs by grade of staff and activity. During the Reporting Period, the Joint Liquidators' time costs amounted to 46 hours at a total cost of £21,918 with an average hourly rate of £482. The time costs incurred predominantly relate to the following matters:
  - Liaising with AOI and its tax advisors to finalise and file corporation tax return for the year ended 6 July 2022 and arranging settlement of associated liabilities;
  - Providing detail to AOI of receipts and payments;
  - Reconciling the AOI Intercompany balance with the Company;
  - Dealing with the renewal of the software licence;
  - Declaring a second capital distribution to the Member;
  - Statutory matters and obligations required to be undertaken by Joint Liquidators, including reporting;
  - Periodic case review and diary management to ensure case progression; and
  - Cashiering and treasury matters in relation to the operation of the liquidation bank account.
- In accordance with their engagement letter, the Joint Liquidators have been paid remuneration to date of £20,310 plus VAT and disbursements of £552 plus VAT.
- 3.4 Furthermore, remuneration of £4,320 plus VAT relating to the liquidation of SIL has been drawn from the liquidation estate. This payment was requested to be made by the Member as SIL does not operate a liquidation bank account.
- 3.5 The Joint Liquidators fees and Liquidation expenses for the Reporting Period total £221,774 (net of VAT) and these are shown in the table below:

3.6 All VAT incurred is recoverable as the Company was registered for VAT. All VAT incurred during the liquidation has been recovered except for a residual amount of £955 which is being reclaimed but remains outstanding from HMRC as at the end of the Reporting Period.



#### 4. Joint Liquidators' Receipts and Payments Account

4.1 Detailed receipts and payments accounts for the Reporting Period and the Cumulative Period are shown at Appendix 1. There is a cash balance of £137,734 remaining in the liquidation estate.

#### 5. Statement of Member's Rights

#### 6. Conclusion

- 6.1 The Joint Liquidators will be in the position to close the Liquidation once Corporation Tax, VAT and PAYE clearances from HMRC have been received.
