Notes to the Accounts for the year ended 31 May 2016

1 Accounting Policies

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention, in accordance with applicable accounting standards and follow the FRSSE Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting by Charities 2015. The following are the accounting policies which have been applied in dealing with material items:-

a) Donated and grant income:

Donated income and grants receivable are taken into account when received by the charity. Income received in circumstances where a claim for repayment of tax has been or will be made to the Inland Revenue is grossed up for the tax recoverable. Any amount of tax reclaimed from the Inland Revenue but not yet received is shown within the charity's debtors.

The charity has relied significantly upon volunteers in carrying out its activities during the year. In accordance with paragraph 6.19 of the SORP, the role of volunteers has not been recognised as income from donated services in the accounts.

b) Other income and expenditure:

Investment income is taken in to account when receivable and expenditure, including irrecoverable VAT, when incurred by the charity, regardles of when payment is made. Grants payable are taken in to account at the earlier of when they are paid or become legally enforceable.

c) Funds:

Unrestricted funds are donations and other income received or generated for the objects of the charity without specified purpose and are available for purposes as directed by the trustees. Restricted funds are amounts received where the donor has specified the purpose for which it should be used.

- d) The company is a registered charity and is exempt from taxation under the Income & Corporation Taxes Act
- e) The company has taken advantage of the exemption provided by the Financial Reporting Standard 1 and has not prepared a Cash Flow Statement for the year.
