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REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS for the year ended 31 May 2015

The Directors have pleasure in submitting the Report and Accounts for the year.

Objects of the charity

The Trust seeks to advance the Christian faith in accordance with the Statements of Beliefs in the Schedule that is documented in the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the charity.

Government

The policy and operating decisions of the charity rest with the Directors who meet regularly to monitor the activities of the Company.

Review of Activities

We were able to resource churches with people who volunteered their time and energy to reach people in need and promote social welfare in the communities in which these churches are there to serve.

Many great opportunities this past year have enabled us to share the gospel in England, Scotland and Wales! Three examples below:

Our GO TEAM in Exmouth (England) was made up of a choir from Manley Baptist Church in Morristown, Tennessee. The choir was able to interact with the coral group of a large college in Exmouth and hold a concert for the community. Another concert in the town centre was attended by the mayor of Exmouth. The church building was full on several occasions during the visit from the choir. The interaction between British and American Christians was beneficial to both groups!

Our GO TEAM Caldicot (Wales) was a great success with many Christians from different American churches joining Bethany Baptist Church to reach out to those in need in the community. Their were many occasions to minister to the community such as doing gardening work in a local nursing home and interacting with local youth in the town.

Our GO TEAM Kelty (Scotland) partnered with Kelty Evangelical Church and visited many homes in the community and also interacted with many of the local youth in the town. The team also offered course on debt counseling to the community. One of the local church member who was recently lost his wife was able to visit some of the team members in the USA.

Reserves Policy

The Board of Directors will establish a policy for reserves held by the charity when it has fully started operations.

Risk Statement

The Directors have reviewed the risks to which a small charity operating without employees has, and is satisfied that procedures are in place to identify, monitor and review these risks on a regular basis.

Notes to the Accounts for the year ended 31 May 2015

1 Accounting Policies

The accounts have been prepared under the historic cost convention, in accordance with applicable accounting standards and follow the Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting by Charities. The following are the accounting policies which have been applied in dealing with material items:-

a) Donated and grant income:

Donated income and grants receivable are taken into account when received by the charity. Income received in circumstances where a claim for repayment of tax has been or will be made to the Inland Revenue is grossed up for the tax recoverable. Any amount of tax reclaimed from the Inland Revenue but not yet received is shown within the charity's debtors.

b) Other income and expenditure:

Investment income is taken in to account when receivable and expenditure, including irrecoverable VAT, when incurred by the charity, regardles of when payment is made. Grants payable are taken in to account at the earlier of when they are paid or become legally enforceable.

c) Funds:

Unrestricted funds are donations and other income received or generated for the objects of the charity without specified purpose and are available for purposes as directed by the trustees. Restricted funds are amounts received where the donor has specified the purpose for which it should be used.

- d) The company is a registered charity and is exempt from taxationunder the Income & Corporation Taxes Act
- e) The company has taken advantage of the exemption provided by the Financial Reporting Standard 1 and has not prepared a Cash Flow Statement for the year.
