Every member of the charity undertakes to contribute such amount as may be required (not exceeding £10) to the charity's assets if it should be wound up while he or she is a member or within one year after he or she ceases to be a member, for payment of the charity's debts and liabilities contracted before he or she ceases to be a member, and of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up, and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The Foundation is managed by a board of trustees supported by the secretary.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

The foundation provides grants to students attending UK universities as well as Universities abroad.

Dontchev Foundation has sponsored the construction of new building of school complex including kindergarden, primary school, junior high-school, high-school and a sports center named "Bulgarsko Shkolo". The building has been fully operational since the last quarter of 2012. "Bulgarsko Shkolo" EAD has long-term renting contracts with the license holders of the kindergarden - "Slunchevo Zaiche", the school - ChSOU "Bulgarsko Shkolo" where over 400 students are educated in the school year 2014/15.

"BG Shkolo" EAD has also concluded a long-term contract for renting the sports facilities - swimming pool, basketball arena, fitness club, tennis court and basketball field.

INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF DONTCHEV FOUNDATION

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 October 2015 which are set out on pages 6 to 10.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, except for investments which are included at market value, and in accordance with applicable United Kingdom accounting standards and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities' issued in March 2005 (SORP 2005).

Consolidation

In the opinion of the members of the committee, the charity and its subsidiary undertakings comprise a small group. The charity has therefore taken advantage of the exemption provided by Section 139 of the Charities Act 2011 not to prepare group accounts.

The directors do not consider the cost of preparing consolidated accounts justifiable and note 9 provides adequate details relating to the nature of the trading subsidairy.

Cash flow statement

The trustees have taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard No 1 (revised) from including a cash flow statement in the financial statements on the grounds that the charity is small.
