

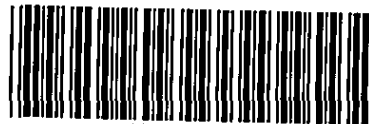

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## **Directors' report**

The directors present their report and the financial statements of Channel 4 Radio Services Limited ("the Company") for the year ended 31 December 2010

## **Principal Activities**

The Company was incorporated for the purpose of the provision of radio data services. Channel Four Television Corporation ("the Corporation") took the decision to withdraw from its 4Radio venture in 2008. As a result, all digital radio activities have now ceased.

The Company has met the requirements of the Companies Act 2006 to obtain the exemption provided from the presentation of an enhanced business review on the grounds of size. The results for the year are set out on pages 6 to 9 of these financial statements.

## **Ownership**

The Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Channel 4 Radio Limited. The ultimate parent company is the Corporation.

## **Results and dividends**

The company generated no turnover and incurred no costs during the year. The directors do not recommend the payment of a dividend (2009: £nil).

## **Directors**

The directors who held office during the year and to the date of this report were as follows:

## **Going concern**

The directors have a reasonable expectation that the company has adequate resources to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future and thus they continue to adopt the going concern basis in preparing the annual financial statements. The Company has received assurances from its ultimate parent, Channel Four Television Corporation, that it will continue to provide financial support, for a minimum of twelve months from the date of the approval of these financial statements, to enable the Company to meet its liabilities as they fall due.

The directors who held office at the date of approval of this directors' report confirm that, so far as they are each aware, there is no relevant audit information of which the Company's auditors are unaware, and each director has taken all the steps that he and she ought to have taken as a director to make himself and herself aware of any relevant audit information and to establish that the Company's auditors are aware of that information.

## **Auditors**

Pursuant to Section 487 of the Companies Act 2006, the auditors will be deemed to be reappointed and KPMG LLP will therefore continue in office.

**Statement of directors' responsibilities in respect of the Directors' report and the financial statements**

The directors are responsible for preparing the Directors' Report and the financial statements in accordance with applicable law and regulations

#### 1. Accounting policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the financial statements

#### Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and under the historical cost accounting rules

At 31 December 2010 the Company had net assets of £1. The Company has received assurances from its ultimate parent, Channel Four Television Corporation, that it will continue to provide financial support, for a minimum of twelve months from the date of the approval of these financial statements, to enable the Company to meet its liabilities as they fall due

Under FRS 1 the Company is exempt from the requirement to prepare a cash flow statement on the grounds that a parent undertaking includes the Company in its own published consolidated financial statements

As the Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Channel 4 Radio Limited the Company has taken advantage of the exemption contained in FRS 8 and has therefore not disclosed transactions or balances with entities which are wholly owned by the group. The consolidated financial statements of Channel Four Television Corporation, within which this Company is included, can be obtained from the address given in note 7
