#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principle accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below and have remained unchanged for the period, and have also been consistently applied within the period.

#### **Cash Flow Statement**

The company qualifies as a small company and advantage has therefore been taken of the exemption provided by the Financial Reporting Standard No 1 not to prepare a cash flow statement.

#### **Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements**

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

The effect of the events in relation to the year ended 30 APRIL 2018 which occurred before the date of approval of the financial statements by the Director, have been included in the statement to the extent required to show a true and fair view of the state of affairs at 30 APRIL 2018 and of the results for the year ended on that date.

#### **Depreciation**

Depreciation has been computed to write off the cost of tangible fixed assets over their expected useful lives using the following rates:

Fixtures and fittings - 25% per annum on reducing balance basis

Plant and machinery - 25% per annum on reducing balance basis

#### **Deferred taxation**

Deferred taxation is provided on the liability method to take account of timing differences between the treatment of certain items for accounts purposes and their treatment for tax purposes.
