ORDINARY RESOLUTIONS:


- A. (i) **THAT** under the terms of the Companies Act 2006 and on the adoption of the new Articles of Association of the Company (as per the below) the authorised share capital of the Company be dispensed with, and limits applied to the Directors' authority as set out in the new Articles attached.
- (ii) **THAT** the 800 issued shares held by TIMOTHY HOPKINS be reclassified as "A" Ordinary Shares of £1 each, the 150 issued shares held by DAVID SARGEANT be reclassified as "B" Ordinary Shares of £1 each and the 50 issued shares held by PHILIP COLEMAN be reclassified as "C" Ordinary Shares of £1 each. The new Articles will allow for a share capital that is comprised of "A" Ordinary Shares of £1 each, "B" Ordinary Shares of £1 each and "C" Ordinary Shares of £1 each
- B. **THAT** the Directors be unconditionally authorised pursuant to S.551 of the Companies Act 2006 to allot shares in the share capital of the Company which are unissued at the time of the passing of this resolution at any time or times during the period of five years from the date hereof.
