1 Accounting Policies

Basis of measurement and preparation of accounts

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities effective April 2008.

Turnover policy

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods and services, excluding value added tax.

Tangible assets depreciation policy

Depreciation is provided on at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset a straight line basis over its estimated useful life.

Office equipment - 25%

Intangible assets amortisation policy

Goodwill and customer contracts, being the amount paid in connection with the acquisition of a business in 2008, was amortised over its estimated useful life of three years.

Foreign currencies

3 Fixed assets Investments

On the 3 April 2012 the Company acquired 100% of the ordinary share capital of RevUpNet, LLC, a company based in Santa Barbara. The total consideration was \$2 million split between cash on completion (\$500,000), deferred commission to be settled in cash within twelve months of the completion date (\$250,000) and a convertible promissory note of \$1,250,000.
