

GlobalEd's activities are based on 15 years of working to service the needs of the Peruvian state schools in ESD, whilst filling a hole in UK ESD (the South American perspective on global issues).

All of GlobalEd's activities are therefore in response to the needs of our stakeholders, the schools and educational community of Peru and the UK. Because the need is so great (in basic ESD development in Peru and with the South American perspective for schools in the UK) our work has to be measured and implemented within our own capacities. A constant process of consultation is followed throughout the year through visits, programme development, correspondence and communication using SKYPE VC facilities, and all digital formats of information sharing with ouir stakeholders in both countries.
