Eda'at is electronic files specialised in specific subjects. ARSCO has launched three versions of it as follows:

- ii. Al-talaweth al-eshai i.e. Radioactive pollution and health complications of the gulf wars.
- iii. Al-intehal al- ilmi i.e. Scientific plagiarism

2- Participation in International Year of Light 2015

- i. Arab Scientific Community Organization and Dr. Moza Al-Rabban (General Director) assigned as a representative (Focal Point) of IYL 2015 in QATAR by UNESCO.
- ii. Articles, videos and interviews related to IYL 2015, are published and done successfully during this year.
- iii. IYL's Agenda for all events and activities related to this occasion in all Arab world, prepared and published.

4- Improvement and monitoring of the ARSCO website has continued, in structure and content with a growing number of worldwide visitors and nearly 550,000 page views during the year from 165 countries worldwide.

5- Different kinds of newsletter are published, weekly and on special occasions.

6- The website continues to carry information about meetings and gatherings in various scientific fields providing a valuable source of information for the scientific community.

7- Information and scientometrics studies on recent scientific research in the Arab world is presented regularly on a weekly basis, highlighting the contributors and their countries.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The surplus for the year amounted to US \$1,443 (2014 deficit - US \$1,078).

Reserves

The charity is dependent upon the support of its well wishers. It is the trustees' intention to build up reserves to a level which will permit continuation of the charity's activities for a period of at least 9 to 12 months without seeking further contributions or donations.

PLANS FOR FUTURE PERIODS

ARSCO will continue its main activity of providing a platform for the advancement and exchange of scientific knowledge within the Arab scientific community.



**INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF ARAB

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2015 which are set out on pages 8 to 12.

RESPECTIVE RESPONSIBILITIES OF TRUSTEES AND EXAMINER

The trustees (who are also the directors of Arab Scientific Community Organisation for the purposes of company law) are responsible for the preparation of the accounts.
