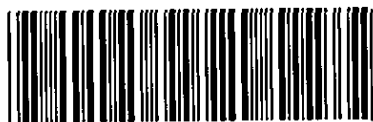

ORDER

UPON the application by Claim Form issued on 11 November 2016 of the above-named Gift-Library.Com (in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation acting by its liquidators Mark Reynolds and Lloyd Edward Hinton) ("the Claimant")

AND UPON reading the evidence, the waiver letter from the Treasury Solicitor dated 13 January 2017, and the email from Mr Kiernan Walker on behalf of the Treasury Solicitor sent to the Claimant at 17.3 on 22 March 2017

AND UPON leave being given to amend the Claim Form to show the name of the Claimant as "Gift-Library.com Limited (in creditors' voluntary liquidation acting by its liquidators Mark Reynolds and Lloyd Edward Hinton)(company number 06651133)"

AND UPON hearing Miss Madeline Dixon, Counsel for the Claimant, and the Defendant being neither in attendance nor represented

AND UPON the Claimant undertaking:

(A) That it will take no action regarding the realisation or disposal of the assets of the CSB 123 Limited ("the Company") until a liquidator has been appointed

AND UPON the court being satisfied that it is just and equitable that the Company be wound up pursuant to section 122(1)(g) of the Insolvency Act 1986 upon its name being restored to the Register of Companies and that it has jurisdiction to order that the Company be wound up of its own motion, notwithstanding that no petition has been presented for the winding up of the Company

AND UPON the court being satisfied on the evidence that the EC Regulation on Insolvency Proceedings does apply and that these proceedings are main proceedings as defined in Article 3 of the EC Regulation

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The name of the above named CSB 123 Limited be restored to the Register of Companies.
2. If at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 ("the Act") change the name of the Company to 07367654 Limited.
3. An Office Copy of this Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the Company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off.
4. The Company be wound up by this Court of its own motion under the provisions of the Insolvency Act 1986.
5. The Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in the London Gazette.
6. The Claimant do pay the Registrar of Companies his costs of the said Application in the sum of £300.
