1. **ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared using the going concern basis although the company has net liabilities at the balance sheet date. Nevertheless, the director believes this basis to be appropriate because the company can continue to rely on the director for financial support. At 31 May 2015 the director was owed a total of £14,790 and a company under common control of the director, Nathan Samuel Limited was also owed £50,651. In any case these amounts will not be repaid until the company is financially secure.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax.

Goodwill

Goodwill, being the amount paid in connection with the acquisition of a business in 2013, is being amortised evenly over its estimated useful life of five years.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery etc - 25% on reducing balance

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.
