APPENDIX A

ADMINISTRATOR'S STATEMENT OF PROPOSALS

It is proposed that

- 1 The Administrator continues to manage the business, affairs and property of the Company in such a manner as he considers expedient with a view to achieving the statutory purposes of the Administration
- 2 If appropriate, the Administrator files a notice with the Registrar of Companies in order that the Administration will cease and the Company will move automatically into Creditors Voluntary Liquidation. It is further proposed that Timothy James Heaselgrave be appointed Liquidator of the Company. Creditors may nominate a different person as the proposed Liquidator, provided that the nomination is made after receipt of these proposals and before the proposals are approved. NB Creditors may nominate a different person as the proposed Liquidator, provided that the nomination is made after receipt of these proposals and before the proposals are approved
- 3 In the event that there are no monies remaining to be distributed to creditors and as soon as all matters relating to the Administration have been completed, the Administrator files a Notice with the Registrar of Companies that the Company should be dissolved
- 4 The Administrator investigates and, if appropriate, pursues any claims that he or the Company may have against any directors or former directors, other third parties, officers or former officers, advisers or former advisers of the Company
- 5 The Administrator shall do all such other things and generally exercise all of his powers as contained in Schedule 1 of the Insolvency Act 1986, as he considers desirable or expedient to achieve the statutory purpose of the Administration
