To this end WRCIC deliver interviews and surveys to 10 groups of 64 young men aged 13 -15 attending Childwall Sports Science Academy (CSSA), Liverpool.

Delivered Relationships and Sex Education workshops to Six groups of young men. totaling 171 young men aged 14 -15 and attending CSSA.

Delivered six Relationships to workshops to 176 young people aged 14-15 in St. Bede's RC Secondary Schools, Ormskirk, East Lancs

Working Relationships CIC delivered 4 anti-bullying/inclusion programmes each comprising seven 1 hour workshop 154 children aged 4 -10 attending Warrington C of Primary Schools, Birchwood, Warrington.


