ORDER

UPON the application of Malcolm Cohen and others ("the **Application**")

AND UPON reading the witness statements of Christopher Marsden and Malcolm Cohen

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The insolvency proceedings listed in the Schedules attached hereto which are not currently before the Business and Property Courts of England and Wales (“**B&PCs**”) be transferred to the B&PCs for the purposes of the Application only, and the Applicants do ensure that a sealed copy of this Order be lodged with the Court having jurisdiction over each case affected by this Order so that a copy of this Order can be placed on each insolvency case file.
2. The First Respondent, Christopher Marsden, is removed from his office as Liquidator in respect of the company in Members’ Voluntary Liquidation which is set out in Schedule A hereto.
3. The First Applicant, Malcolm Cohen, is appointed as Liquidator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the company which is set out in Schedule A hereto.
4. The First Respondent, Christopher Marsden is removed from his office as Liquidator in respect of the companies in Creditors’ Voluntary Liquidation which are set out in Schedule B hereto.
5. The Second Applicant, Simon Edward Jex Girling, is appointed as Liquidator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the companies which are set out in Schedule B hereto in which he is identified as proposed appointee.
6. The Third Applicant, Danny Nicolaas William Dartnaill, is appointed as Liquidator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the companies which are set out in Schedule B hereto in which he is identified as proposed appointee.
7. The Fourth Applicant, Lee Causer, is appointed as Liquidator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the companies which are set out in Schedule B hereto in which he is identified as proposed appointee.
8. The Fifth Applicant, John Strowger, is appointed as Liquidator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the company which is set out in Schedule B hereto in which he is identified as proposed appointee.
9. The Sixth Applicant, James Bernard Stephen, is appointed as Liquidator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the companies which are set out in Schedule B hereto in which he is identified as proposed appointee.
10. The Seventh Applicant, Kiri Holland, is appointed as Liquidator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the company which is set out in Schedule B hereto in which she is identified as proposed appointee.
11. The First Respondent, Christopher Marsden, is removed from his office as Administrator in respect of the companies in Administration which are set out in Schedule C hereto.

12. The Second Applicant, Simon Edward Jex Girling, is appointed as Administrator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the company which is set out in Schedule C hereto in which he is identified as proposed appointee.
13. The Third Applicant, Danny Nicolaas William Dartnaill, is appointed as Administrator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the company which is set out in Schedule C hereto in which he is identified as proposed appointee.
14. The Fourth Applicant, Lee Causer, is appointed as Administrator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the company which is set out in Schedule C hereto in which he is identified as proposed appointee.
15. The Fifth Applicant, John Strowger, is appointed as Administrator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the company which is set out in Schedule C hereto in which he is identified as proposed appointee.
16. The Eighth Applicant, Mark Patterson, is appointed as Administrator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the companies which are set out in Schedule C hereto in which he is identified as proposed appointee.
17. The First Respondent, Christopher Marsden, is removed from his office as Administrator in respect of the limited liability partnership in Administration which is set out in Schedule D attached hereto.
18. The Eighth Applicant, Mark Patterson, is appointed as Administrator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the limited liability partnership which is set out in Schedule D attached hereto.
19. The Applicants shall procure that, at the first convenient opportunity to do so, and in any event within 3 months of the date of the Order, a block advertisement in respect of each of the insolvency appointments listed in Schedules A,B,C and D shall be placed in the London Gazette containing notification of the removal of the First Respondent and the substitution of the First Respondent by the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh or Eighth Applicant, as the case may be and the matters set out at paragraphs 22 - 24 (inclusive) of this Order.
20. In relation to the insolvency proceedings listed in the Schedules hereto, and insofar as the Insolvency Act 1986 or the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 contain any requirement for advertisement of the removal of the First Respondent or his substitution by the Applicants, compliance with paragraph 19 above shall be deemed as being sufficient compliance with any such advertisement provisions and for the avoidance of doubt, any further compliance with such notice provisions shall be waived. Insofar as the First Respondent is required by law to give any notice of his removal from office, the Applicants (and each of them) are entitled to sign and send any such notice on his behalf.
21. The period to be covered by progress reports to members and/or creditors and the dates by which those reports need to be sent to members and/or creditors and filed with the Registrar of Companies (if applicable) shall not be altered by virtue of the

making of the Order or the replacement of the First Respondent by the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh or Eighth Applicant, as the case may be, pursuant to this Order; and for the avoidance of doubt, any such requirement necessitating an alteration in the reporting dates by reason of the date of commencement, termination or replacement of an office holder's appointment, are hereby waived to the effect that the next progress report shall refer to this Order.

22. In each of the Liquidations listed in Schedules A and B, the First Respondent will be entitled to apply to the Secretary of State for his release upon the expiry of 28 days from the date the notice has been advertised, SAVE that in the event that an application in relation to one of the insolvency appointments has been made by a creditor (or a member in the case of the Members' Voluntary Liquidation) within the relevant time period, objecting to the said release, the First Respondent will not seek to apply for his release in relation to that insolvency appointment until after the said application has been disposed of (whether by agreement or by order of the Court).
23. In each of the Administrations listed in Schedule C and D, the First Respondent will be released from all liability both in respect of any of his acts and omissions in relation to his conduct as office-holder of the estates with effect from 28 days from the date when the notice has been advertised, SAVE that in the event that an application in relation to one of the insolvency appointments has been made by a creditor, within the relevant time period, objecting to the said release, the First Respondent will be released in relation to the said insolvency appointment 28 days after the said application has been disposed of (whether by agreement or by order of the Court) or further order of the Court in the meantime.
24. Creditors (and members in the case of the Members' Voluntary Liquidation) have liberty to apply, within 28 days after the notice has been advertised, to vary or discharge the Order and or to object to the First Respondent's release.
25. Insofar as Christopher Marsden was a joint office holder in any of the insolvency appointments set out in the Schedules, unless otherwise already provided the replacement office-holder may exercise all powers jointly with the co-office holders or separately.
26. The costs of and occasioned by the Application shall be paid by BDO.
27. There be liberty to apply.
