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1 Accounting policies

Basis of preparation

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated accounts have been extracted, have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (Effective April 2008).

Going concern

At 31 December 2014 the company's balance sheet showed a deficit on shareholders' funds of £84,110. The company is dependent for its day to day working capital on the support of its parent company. The director considers that this support will continue for a period of twelve months from the date of approval of these financial statements. The director therefore judges that it is appropriate to prepare these financial statements on a going concern basis and no adjustments have been made which would require to be made if that basis were to be inappropriate.

Turnover

Turnover represents amounts chargeable, net of value added tax, in respect of membership subscriptions and sale of goods and services to members. Subscriptions are recognised as income over the period to which they relate. Where subscriptions are received in advance, the amount of income in relation to future periods is deferred at the balance sheet date.

Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on tangible fixed assets so as to write off the cost or valuation, less any estimated residual value, over their expected useful economic life as follows:

Asset class	Depreciation method and rate
Plant and machinery	Reducing balance at 25%
Fixtures and fittings	Reducing balance at 25%
Office equipment	Reducing balance at 25%

Stock

Stock is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after due regard for obsolete and slow moving stocks. Net realisable value is based on selling price less anticipated costs to completion and selling costs.

Hire purchase and leasing

Rentals payable under operating leases are charged in the profit and loss account on a straight line basis over the lease term.

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Financial instruments

Financial instruments are classified and accounted for, according to the substance of the contractual arrangement, as financial assets, financial liabilities or equity instruments. An equity instrument is any contract that evidences a residual interest in the assets of the company after deducting all of its liabilities. Where shares are issued, any component that creates a financial liability of the company is presented as a liability in the balance sheet. The corresponding dividends relating to the liability component are charged as interest expense in the profit and loss account.
