1 Accounting policies

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015). The principal activity of the company is exposed to inherent uncertainties and global market fluctuations beyond the control of the management of the company.
