Director's report For the period ended 31 March 2015

The director presents her report and the unaudited financial statements for the period ended 31 March 2015.

Director's responsibilities statement

The director is responsible for preparing the Director's report and the financial statements in accordance with applicable law and regulations.

Company law requires the director to prepare financial statements for each financial year. Under that law the director has elected to prepare the financial statements in accordance with United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice (United Kingdom Accounting Standards and applicable law). Under company law the director must not approve the financial statements unless she is satisfied that they give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the company and of the surplus or deficit of the company for that period. In preparing these financial statements, the director is required to:

- select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;
- make judgments and accounting estimates that are reasonable and prudent;
- prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the company will continue in business.

The director is responsible for keeping adequate accounting records that are sufficient to show and explain the company's transactions and disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the company and enable her to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act 2006. She is also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the company and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

Principal activities

The company was formed to campaign in advance of the Scottish independence referendum.

Just over £147,000 was spent during the official campaign period and this was compliant with the Electoral Commission rules.

The pre - official campaign started at the beginning of May 2014 and this included a national press campaign reaching 85% Scottish electorate. Cinema films and posters were also part of this launch programme.

During the campaign, social media was used extensively reaching at its peak over 450,000 people each week. A website was created and ran throughout the campaign. Other campaign initiatives included: a campaign song "why build another wall?"; a bicycle rally "Zigzag across the border"; the World premiere of the Unity suite composed by Eddie McGuire at Adelaide's in Glasgow.

The campaign was closed after the successful outcome of the Referendum.

The company was formed to campaign in advance of the Scottish independence referendum in September 2014. As such, after the year end the director will commence winding up procedures and close the company. Therefore, the going concern basis is not appropriate and the accounts have been prepared on a break up basis. No adjustments are needed to the value of assets and liabilities in the company with regard to this treatment.

1.3 Cash flow

The financial statements do not include a Cash flow statement because the company, as a small reporting entity, is exempt from the requirement to prepare such a statement under the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).
