Nothing in this clause shall limit the right of Reward to take proceedings against the Company in any other court of competent jurisdiction, nor shall the taking of proceedings in any one or more jurisdictions preclude the taking of proceedings in any other jurisdictions, whether concurrently or not, to the extent permitted by the law of such other jurisdiction.

Other Service

14.3 The Company irrevocably consents to any process in any legal action or proceedings arising out of or in connection with this debenture being served on it in accordance with the provisions of this debenture relating to service of notices. Nothing contained in this debenture shall affect the right to serve process in any other manner permitted by law.

This document has been executed as a deed and is delivered and takes effect on the date stated at the beginning of it

 - all deeds and documents of title relating to the Charged Property which are in the possession or control of the Company (if these are not within the possession and/or control of the Company, the Company undertakes to obtain possession of all such deeds and documents of title),

- 2 1 3 If called on so to do by Reward, execute a legal assignment of the Book Debts to Reward in such terms as Reward may require and give notice of that assignment to the debtors from whom the Book Debts are due, owing or incurred

3. Insurance Covenant

3.1 The Company

- 3.1.1 shall (if Reward so requires) produce to, or deposit with, Reward all Insurance Policies and the receipts for all premiums and other payments necessary for effecting and keeping up such policies; and

 - 4.13 at the option of Reward, be applied in making good or recouping expenditure in respect of the loss or damage for which such monies are received or in or towards discharge or reduction of the Secured Obligations (but subject to paragraph 12 of Schedule 5)

business on those parts (if any) of the Properties as are or may be used for the purposes of trade or business

4. Planning Information

4.1 The Company shall

- 4.1.1 give full particulars to Reward of any notice, order, direction, designation, resolution or proposal given or made by any planning authority or other public body or authority (Planning Notice) that specifically applies to any Property, or to the locality in which it is situated, within seven days after becoming aware of the relevant Planning Notice; and
- 4 1.2 (If Reward so requires) immediately, and at the cost of the Company, take all reasonable and necessary steps to comply with any Planning Notice, and make, or join with Reward in making, such objections or representations in respect of any such Planning Notice as Reward may desire.

5. Compliance with Covenants and Payment of Rent

- 5.1.1 observe and perform all covenants, stipulations and conditions to which each Property, or the use of it, is or may be subjected and (if Reward so requires) produce to Reward evidence sufficient to satisfy Reward that those covenants, stipulations and conditions have been observed and performed, and
- 5 1.2 (without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) where a Property, or part of it, is held under a lease, duly and punctually pay all rents due from time to time and perform and observe all the tenant's covenants and conditions.

6. Maintenance of Interests in Properties

- 6.1 The Company shall not, without the prior written consent of Reward.
 - 6 1 1 grant, or agree to grant, any licence or tenancy affecting the whole or any part of any Property, or exercise the statutory powers of leasing (or

- agreeing to lease) or of accepting (or agreeing to accept) surrenders under sections 99 or 100 of the Law of Property Act 1925; or
- 6 1.2 In any other way dispose of, or agree to dispose of, surrender or create any legal or equitable estate or interest in the whole or any part of any Property

7. Registration Restrictions

7 1 The Company shall procure that no person shall be registered under the Land Registration Acts 1925 to 2002 as proprietor of any Property without the prior written consent of Reward The Company shall be liable for the Costs of Reward in lodging cautions against the registration of the title to the whole or any part of any Property from time to time

8. Development Restrictions

The Company shall not, without the prior written consent of Reward, carry out or permit or suffer to be carried out on any Property any development as defined in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 or change or permit or suffer to be changed the use of any Property.

9. Environment

 - 1 1 1 2 immediately upon receipt, forward to Reward all communications or other information received in respect of any Investments for which it has been so nominated, and
- at the direction of Reward given at any time, immediately execute and deliver to Reward all transfers and other documents and do all such things as may be necessary or desirable to register all or any of the Investments in the name of Reward or its nominee.
- 1 2 The Company shall not during the Security Period exercise any rights under sections 145 and 146 of the Companies Act 2006 to nominate any person in respect of any of the Investments.

2. Additional Registration Obligations

- 2 1 The Company shall.
 - 2.1.1 procure all consents, waivers, approvals and permissions which are necessary, under the articles of association of any issuer that is not a public company or otherwise, for the transfer of the Investments to Reward or its nominee, or to a purchaser on enforcement of this debenture, and
 - 2 1 2 procure the amendment of the share transfer provisions of the articles of association of each issuer that is not a public company in such manner as Reward may require in order to permit such a transfer.

3. Dividends and Voting Rights Post Enforcement

- 3 1 After the security constituted by this debenture has become enforceable:
 - 3 1 1 all dividends and other distributions paid in respect of the Investments and received by the Company shall be held on trust for Reward and immediately paid into a Designated Account or, if received by Reward, shall be retained by Reward, and
 - all voting and other rights and powers attaching to the Investments shall be exercised by, or at the direction of, Reward and the Company shall, and shall procure that its nominees shall, comply with any directions Reward may, in its absolute discretion, give concerning the exercise of those rights and powers.

4. Calls on Investments

4 1 The Company shall duly and promptly pay all calls, instalments and other monies which may be payable from time to time in respect of the Investments. The Company acknowledges that Reward shall not be under any liability in respect of any such calls, instalments or other monies.

5. No alteration of Investments

The Company shall not, without the prior written consent of Reward, amend, or agree to the amendment of, the memorandum or articles of association or any other constitutional documents of any issuer that is not a public company, or the rights or liabilities attaching to any of the Investments

6. Preservation of Investments

- The Company shall ensure (insofar as it is able by the exercise of all voting rights, powers of control and other means available to it to do so) that no issuer that is not a public company shall.
 - 6.1.1 consolidate or subdivide any of its Investments, or reduce or re-organise its share capital in any way,
 - 6.1 2 Issue any new shares or stock, or
 - 6 1 3 refuse to register any transfer of any of its Investments which may be lodged for registration by, or on behalf of, Reward or the Company in accordance with this debenture.

7. Investments Information

7 1 The Company shall, send to Reward copies of all notices, circulars, reports, accounts and other documents, which are sent to holders of any Investments, promptly following receipt

Part V Equipment covenants

1. Maintenance of Equipment

- 1 1 The Company shall
 - 1.1.1 maintain the Equipment in good and serviceable condition (except for expected fair wear and tear), and
 - 1 1 2 not to permit any Equipment to be:
 - 1.1 2 1 used or handled, other than by properly qualified and trained persons; or
 - 1 1 2.2 to be overloaded or used for any purpose for which it is not designed or reasonably suitable.

2. Payment of Equipment Taxes

2 1 The Company shall promptly pay all taxes, fees, licence duties, registration charges, insurance premiums and other outgoings in respect of the Equipment and, on demand, produce evidence of payment to Reward

3. Equipment Information

- 3.1 The Company shall:
 - 3 1.1 give Reward such information concerning the location, condition, use and operation of Equipment as Reward may require, and
 - 3.1 2 permit any persons designated by Reward to inspect and examine Equipment and the records relating to Equipment at all reasonable times.

4. Equipment Insurance

- 4 1 The Company shall:
 - 4.1 1 at its own expense, procure that the Equipment is covered and kept covered by insurance of a kind satisfactory to Reward with insurers approved by Reward (such approval not to be unreasonably withheld) for full comprehensive insurance cover, which shall include (but not be limited to) fire, theft and accident, for an amount which is not less than the aggregate cost of reinstating or replacing such Equipment;
 - 4.1.2 If Reward so requires, procure that the interest of Reward is noted on all such insurance policies or, at the option of Reward, that such insurance policies are issued in the joint names of Reward and the Company, and
 - 4 1 3 maintain insurance for third party liabilities in such amount, and on such terms, as is usual for users of equipment of the same type as the Equipment

5. Notice of Charge

The Company shall, if so requested by Reward , place and maintain on each item of Equipment, in a conspicuous place, a clearly legible identification plate containing the following wording

"NOTICE OF CHARGE

This [DESCRIPTION OF ITEM] and ancillary equipment is subject to a fixed charge dated 21 for 2015 in favour of Reward Trade Finance Limited"

Part VI Intellectual Property covenants

1. Preservation of Rights

The Company shall take all necessary action to safeguard and maintain present and future rights in, or relating to, the Intellectual Property including (without limitation), observing all covenants and stipulations relating to such rights and paying all applicable renewal fees, licence fees and other outgoings.

2. Registration of Intellectual Property

2 1 The Company shall use all reasonable efforts to effect registration of applications for registration of any Intellectual Property and keep Reward informed of all matters relating to such registration.

3. Maintenance of Intellectual Property

3 1 The Company shall not permit any Intellectual Property to be abandoned, cancelled or to lapse.

Schedule 4 Powers of Reward

1. Power to Remedy

Reward shall be entitled (but shall not be bound) to remedy a breach at any time by the Company of any of its obligations contained in this debenture and the Company irrevocably authorises Reward and its agents to do all such things as are necessary or desirable for that purpose.

2. Exercise of Rights

2 1 The rights of Reward under paragraph 1 of this Schedule 4 are without prejudice to any other rights of Reward under this debenture and the exercise of those rights shall not make Reward liable to account as a mortgagee in possession

3. Power to Dispose of Chattels

- 3 1 At any time after the security constituted by this debenture shall have become enforceable, Reward or any Receiver
 - 3 1 1 may dispose of any chattels or produce found on any Property as agent for the Company, and
 - 3 1 2 without prejudice to any obligation to account for the proceeds of any sale of such chattels or produce, shall be indemnified by the Company against any liability arising from such disposal.

4. Prior Encumbrances

- 4 1 At any time after the security constituted by this debenture shall have become enforceable or after any powers conferred by any Encumbrance having priority to this debenture shall have become exercisable, Reward may
 - 4 1.1 redeem such or any other prior Encumbrance or procure its transfer to itself, and
 - 4 1 2 settle any account of that encumbrancer.
- 4.2 The settlement of any such account shall be conclusive and binding on the Company and all monies paid by Reward to an encumbrancer in settlement of such an account shall, as from its payment by Reward, be due from the Company to Reward on current account and shall bear interest and be secured as part of the Secured Obligations

5. Currencies of Denomination

5.1 For the purpose of or pending the discharge of any of the Secured Obligations Reward may convert any monies received, recovered or realised by Reward under this debenture (including the proceeds of any previous conversion under this paragraph 5) from their existing currencies of denomination into such other currencies of denomination as Reward may think fit and any such conversion shall be effected at Reward's then prevailing spot selling rate of exchange for such other currency against the existing currency. Each previous reference in this paragraph 5 to a currency extends to funds of that currency and for the avoidance of doubt funds of one currency may be converted into different funds of the same currency

6. New Accounts

- 6.1 If Reward receives notice of any subsequent Encumbrance or other interest affecting all or part of the Charged Property, Reward may open a new account or accounts for the Company in Reward's books and (without prejudice to Reward's right to combine accounts) no money paid to the credit of the Company in any such new account will be appropriated towards or have the effect of discharging any part of the Secured Obligations.
- If Reward does not open a new account or accounts immediately on receipt of notice under paragraph 6 1 of this Schedule 4, then, unless Reward gives express written notice to the contrary to the Company, as from the time of receipt of the relevant notice by Reward all payments made by the Company to Reward, in the absence of any express appropriation by the Company to the contrary, shall be treated as having been credited to a new account of the Company and not as having been applied in reduction of the Secured Obligations.

7. Reward's Set-Off Rights

 - 7.1 2 Reward has received notice of any subsequent Encumbrance or other interest affecting all or any part of the Charged Property,

transfer, without prior notice, all or any part of the balance standing to the credit of any account to any other account which may be in debit but Reward shall notify the Company of the transfer once made.

7 2 Reward may at any time and without notice to the Company, set off any liability of the Company to Reward or to any Affiliate of Reward, against any liability of Reward to the Company, whether any such liabilities are actual, contingent, present or future.

8. Indulgence

Reward may in its discretion grant time or other indulgence or make any other arrangement, variation or release with any person or persons not being a party to this debenture (whether or not such person or persons are jointly liable with the Company) in respect of any of the Secured Obligations or of any other security for them without prejudice either to this debenture or to the liability of the Company for the Secured Obligations.

9. Investments: dividends and voting rights prior to enforcement

- 9.1 Until the security constituted by this debenture becomes enforceable.
 - 9 1 1 Reward shall, on request by the Company, release and pay to the Company any cash dividends paid in respect of any of the Investments and received by Reward or its nominee; and
 - 9.1.2 Reward shall, in exercising all voting and other rights and powers of Reward or its nominee attaching to the Investments, act in accordance with the directions of Company from time to time if acting in accordance with those directions would not, in Reward's opinion, prejudice Reward's security under this debenture or the value of the Investments, or contravene any agreement between Reward and the Company

Schedule 5 Enforcement

1. Enforcement Events

- 1.1 This debenture shall be enforceable if:
 - 1.1.1 any of the Secured Obligations shall not be paid or discharged when the same ought to be paid or discharged by the Company (whether on demand or at scheduled maturity or by acceleration or otherwise, as the case may be), or
 - the Company shall be in breach of any of its obligations under this debenture or under any other agreement between the Company and Reward and that breach (if capable of remedy) has not been remedied to the satisfaction of Reward within 3 days of notice by Reward to the Company to remedy the breach, or

1.1.3 the Company

- 1 1.3 1 becomes unable to pay its debts as they fall due (and/or the value of the Company's assets is less than the amount of its liabilities, taking into account the Company's contingent and prospective liabilities); or
- 1.1 3.2 commences negotiations with any one or more of its creditors with a view to the general readjustment or rescheduling of its indebtedness, or
- 1 1.3 3 makes a general assignment for the benefit of, or a composition with, its creditors, or
- 1 1.4 the Company passes any resolution or takes any corporate action or a petition is presented or proceedings are commenced or any action is taken by any person for its winding-up, dissolution, administration or reorganisation or for the appointment of a receiver, administrative receiver, administrator, trustee or similar officer of it or of any or all of its revenues and assets; or
- 1 1.5 a distress, execution, attachment or other legal process is levied or enforced upon or sued against all or any part of the assets of the Company and remains undischarged for seven days; or

- any event occurs in relation to the Company that is analogous to those set out in paragraph 1.1 3, paragraph 1 1 4 or paragraph 1 1.5 of this Schedule 5, or
- 1.1.7 any representation, warranty or statement made or deemed to be made by the Company under this debenture is or proves to have been incorrect or misleading in any material respect when made or deemed to be made.

and in any such event (whether or not the event is continuing), without prejudice to any other rights of Reward, the powers of sale under the Law of Property Act 1925 shall immediately be exercisable and Reward may in its absolute discretion enforce all or any part of the security created by this debenture as it sees fit.

2. Statutory Power of Sale

2.1 The statutory powers of sale conferred by the Law of Property Act 1925 shall, as between Reward and a purchaser from Reward, arise on and be exercisable at any time after the execution of this debenture, but Reward shall not exercise such power of sale until the security constituted by this debenture has become enforceable under paragraph 1 of this Schedule 5

3. Extension of Statutory Powers

The statutory powers of sale, leasing and accepting surrenders conferred upon mortgagees under the Law of Property Act 1925 and/or by any other statute shall be exercisable by Reward under this debenture are extended so as to authorise Reward whether in its own name or in that of the Company to grant a lease or leases of the whole or any part or parts of the freehold and leasehold property of the Company with whatever rights relating to other parts of it and containing whatever covenants on the part of the Company and generally on such terms and conditions (including the payment of money to a lessee or tenant on a surrender) and whether or not at a premium as Reward thinks fit.

 - 4 1 1 to enquire whether any of the Secured Obligations have become due or payable or remain unpaid or undischarged, or whether the power Reward or a Receiver is purporting to exercise has become exercisable; or

4 1 2 to see to the application of any money paid to Reward or any Receiver

5. No liability as Mortgagee in Possession

Neither Reward nor any Receiver nor any Administrator shall be liable to account as mortgagee in possession in respect of all or any of the Charged Property nor shall any of them be liable for any loss upon realisation of, or for any neglect or default of any nature whatsoever in connection with, all or any of the Charged Property for which a mortgagee in possession might as such be liable

6. Appointment of Receiver

- At any time after the security constituted by this debenture becomes enforceable, or at the request of the Company, Reward may without further notice:
 - 6.1 1 appoint under seal or in writing by a duly authorised officer of Reward any one or more person or persons to be a receiver or a receiver and manager of all or any part of the Charged Property, and
 - 6.1.2 (subject to Section 45 of the Insolvency Act 1986) from time to time under seal or in writing by a duly authorised officer of Reward remove any person appointed to be Receiver and may in like manner appoint another in his place
- Where more than one person is appointed Receiver, they will have power to act separately (unless the appointment by Reward specifies to the contrary)
- 6.3 Reward may fix the remuneration of any Receiver appointed by it without the restrictions contained in section 109 of the Law of Property Act 1925 and the remuneration of the Receiver shall be a debt secured by this debenture which shall be due and payable immediately upon its being paid by Reward.

7. Powers Additional

7 1 The powers of sale and appointing a Receiver conferred by this debenture shall be in addition to all statutory and other powers of Reward under the Insolvency Act 1986 and the Law of Property Act 1925 or otherwise and shall be exercisable without the restrictions contained in Sections 103 and 109 of the Law of Property Act 1925 or otherwise

7 2 The power to appoint a Receiver (whether conferred by this debenture or by statute) shall be and remain exercisable by Reward notwithstanding any prior appointment in respect of all or any part of the Charged Property.

8. Agent of the Company

Any Receiver appointed by Reward under this debenture shall be the agent of the Company and the Company shall be solely responsible for his acts and remuneration as well as for any defaults committed by him

9. Powers of Receiver

9.1 Any Receiver appointed by Reward under this debenture shall in addition to the powers conferred on him by the Law of Property Act 1925 and the Insolvency Act 1986 have power to do all such acts and things as an absolute owner could do in the management of such of the Charged Property over which the Receiver is appointed and in particular the powers set out in Schedule 6.

10. Order of Application of Proceeds

- 10 1 All monies received by Reward or a Receiver (other than insurance monies) shall be applied
 - 10 1 1 first in paying all unpaid fees, costs and other liability incurred by or on behalf of Reward (and a Receiver, attorney or agent appointed by it) rents, taxes, rates and outgoings whatever affecting any Charged Property;
 - 10.1 2 second in paying all costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the appointment of any Receiver and the exercise of his powers and all outgoings paid by him,
 - 10 1.3 third in paying the remuneration of any Receiver (as agreed between him and Reward);
 - 10 1 4 fourth in or towards discharge of the Secured Obligations in such order and manner as Reward shall determine, and
 - 10 1 5 finally in paying any surplus to the Company or any other person entitled to it

11. Appropriation

11 1 Neither Reward nor any Receiver shall be bound (whether by virtue of section 109(8) of the Law of Property Act 1925, which is varied accordingly, or otherwise) to pay or appropriate any receipt or payment first towards interest rather than principal or otherwise in any particular order as between any of the Secured Obligations

12. Suspense Account

12.1 All monies received by Reward or a Receiver under this debenture may, at the discretion of Reward or Receiver, be credited to any suspense or securities realised account and shall bear interest at such rate, if any, as may be agreed in writing between Reward and the Company and may be held in such account for so long as Reward or Receiver thinks fit.

13. Power of Attorney

- By way of security the Company irrevocably appoints Reward and every Receiver separately to be the attorney of the Company and, in its name, and on its behalf and as its act and deed, to execute any documents, and do any acts and things which
 - 13 1 1 the Company is required to execute and do under this debenture, including executing any documents required by Reward under paragraph 6 of Part I of Schedule 3, and/or under this debenture, and
 - 13.1.2 any attorney may deem proper or desirable in exercising any of the powers, authorities and discretions conferred by this debenture or by law on Reward or any Receiver.

14. Ratification of Acts of Attorney

14.1 By this debenture the Company ratifies and confirms and agrees to ratify and confirm anything which any of its attorneys may do in the proper and lawful exercise or purported exercise of all or any of the powers, authorities and discretions referred to in paragraph 13 of this Schedule 5

15. Appointment of an Administrator

- 15.1 Reward may, without notice to the Company appoint any one or more persons to be an administrator of the Company pursuant to paragraph 14 Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986 if this debenture becomes enforceable
- 15.2 Any appointment under this paragraph 15 shall.
 - 15 2 1 be in writing signed by a duly authorised signatory of Reward , and
 - 15.2 2 take effect, in accordance with paragraph 19 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986, when the requirements of paragraph 18 of that Schedule B1 are satisfied
- 15.3 Reward may (subject to any necessary approval from the court) end the appointment of an Administrator by notice in writing in accordance with this paragraph 15 and appoint under that paragraph a replacement for any Administrator whose appointment ends for any reason.

Schedule 6 Further Powers of Receiver

1. Power to Repair and Develop Properties

1.1 A Receiver may undertake or complete any works of repair, building or development on the Properties

2. Power to Surrender Leases

2.1 A Receiver may grant or to accept surrenders of any leases or tenancies affecting the Properties upon such terms and subject to such conditions as he thinks fit

3. Power to Employ Personnel and Advisors

3.1 A Receiver may provide services and employ, or engage, such managers contractors and other personnel and professional advisors on such terms as he deems expedient.

4. Power to Make VAT Elections

4.1 A Receiver may make such elections for value added tax purposes as he thinks fit.

5. Power to Charge Remuneration

5.1 A Receiver may charge and receive such sum by way of remuneration (in addition to all costs, charges and expenses incurred by him) as Reward may prescribe or agree with him.

6. Power to Realise Charged Property

6.1 A Receiver may collect and get in the Charged Property in respect of which he is appointed or any part thereof and for that purpose to make such demands and take any proceedings as may seem expedient and to take possession of the Charged Property with like rights.

7. Power to Manage or Reconstruct the Company's Business

7 1 A Receiver may carry on, manage, develop, reconstruct, amalgamate or diversify or concur in carrying on, managing, developing, reconstructing, amalgamating or diversifying the business of the Company.

8. Power to Dispose of Charged Property

A Receiver may grant options and licences over all or any part of the Charged Property, sell or concur in selling, assign or concur in assigning, lease or concur in leasing and accept or concur in accepting surrenders of leases of, all or any of the property of the Company in respect of which he is appointed in such manner and generally on such terms and conditions as he thinks fit (fixtures and plant and machinery may be severed and sold separately from the premises in which they are contained without the consent of the Company) and to carry any such sale, assignment, leasing or surrender into effect. Any such sale may be for such consideration as he shall think fit and he may promote or concur in promoting a Company to purchase the property to be sold.

9. Power to Seli Book Debts

9 1 A Receiver may sell and assign all or any of the Book Debts in respect of which he is appointed in such a manner, and generally on such terms and conditions, as he thinks fit.

10. Power to Make Settlements

10.1 A Receiver may make any arrangement, settlement or compromise between the Company and any other person which he may think expedient.

11. Power to Improve the Equipment

11 1 A Receiver may make substitutions of, or improvements to, the Equipment as he may think expedient.

12. Power to Make Calls On Company Members

12 1 A Receiver may make calls conditionally or unconditionally on the members of the Company in respect of the uncalled capital with such and the same powers for that purpose and for the purpose of enforcing payments of any calls so made as are conferred by the Articles of Association of the Company on its directors in respect of calls authorised to be made by them

13. Power to Appoint Staff and Agents

13.1 A Receiver may appoint managers, officers, servants, workmen and agents for the aforesaid purposes of this Schedule 6 at such salaries and for such periods and on such terms as he may determine

14. Power to Insure

14.1 A Receiver may, if he thinks fit, but without prejudice to the indemnity contained in clause 9, effect with any insurer any policy or policies of insurance either in lieu or satisfaction of, or in addition to, such insurance.

15. Powers under the Law of Property Act 1925

15 1 A Receiver may exercise all powers provided for in the Law of Property Act 1925 in the same way as if he had been duly appointed under that act and to exercise all powers provided for an administrative receiver in Schedule 1 of the Insolvency Act 1986

16. Power to Borrow

16.1 A Receiver may for any of the purposes authorised by this Schedule 6 raise money by borrowing from Reward or from any other person on the security of all or any of the Charged Property in respect of which he is appointed upon such terms (including if Reward shall consent to terms under which such security ranks in priority to this debenture) as he shall think fit.

17. Power to Redeem Prior Encumbrances

17.1 A Receiver may redeem any prior Encumbrance and to settle and pass the accounts to which the Encumbrance relates and any accounts so settled and passed will be conclusive and binding on the Company and the monies so paid will be deemed to be an expense properly incurred by him

18. Incidental Powers

18.1 A Receiver may do all such other acts and things as he may consider incidental or conducive to any of the matters or powers in this Schedule 6 or which he lawfully may or can do as agent for the Company.

19. Scope of Powers

19.1 Any exercise of any of these powers given by this Schedule 6 may be on behalf of the Company, the directors of the Company (in the case of the power contained in paragraph 12 of Schedule 6) or himself
