- 4.2 The saving of lives, the advancement of health, the relief of need, and the preservation and conservation for the public benefit of the physical and natural environment including landscapes, flora and fauna and the furtherance of other purposes recognised as charitable under English law, in particular (but without limitation) in areas affected by conflict around the world,

provided that all activities shall maintain or enhance the charity's commitment to remaining independent and impartial.
